BOUNDARY ALTERATION - FOURTH STATUS REPORT (2023447)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The State Government proclaimed a new Local Government Boundary between South Sydney and Sydney City Councils in Government Gazette Number 47 dated 19th February 2003 - Refer previous Report to Council dated 25th February 2003 (2023447).

The proclamation requires the two Councils to enter into negotiations with a view to presenting a proposal for adoption/determination by the Minister prior to the 17th April 2003 for implementation on 8th May 2003.

Meetings have been ongoing with the City of Sydney since the proclamation.

Based on the above, a final "Position Paper" has been prepared comprising:

1. A table of issues
2. Where agreed, a summary of the agreed position in respect of that issue.
3. Where not agreed, a notation to that effect.

1. the report be received and endorsed.;
2. the General Manager be delegated the authority to negotiate a final position for submission to the Minister for determination.;
3. the General Manager continue to provide regular updates and briefings to Council regarding this matter.
