Proposal Summary: The application seeks consent for provision of essential

infrastructure for the Green Square Town Centre, including demolition of minor structures and tree removal.

construction of new roads, footpaths and associated infrastructure, green infrastructure including electricity, non-drinking recycled water, waste collection and thermal energy, concept landscaping and streetscape design, provision of above and below ground services (including

stormwater, sewer, water, electrical and telecommunications) and staged construction.

The application has been assessed by an independent external planning consultant (MG Planning Pty Ltd) and reported to the Central Sydney Planning Committee to ensure impartiality in the assessment, as Council is the applicant and part owner of the site.
