Thank you for your letter of 28 June 2013 regarding the Ashmore precinct.

The NSW Government is committed to promoting the use of public transport. Patronage and urban development are reviewed regularly to ensure public transport services meet the travel needs of the community.

I understand Transport for NSW has already had several discussions with council regarding the staging and timing of the Ashmore precinct.

As you are aware, the NSW Long Term Transport Master Plan provides a 20 year vision to support the development of Greater Sydney. The Ashmore precinct will benefit with the increase of train capacity on the Bankstown Line, which includes Erskineville and St Peters stations.
