NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPLY TO THE FEDERAL COURT OF AUSTRALIA FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE GENERAL INSURANCE BUSINESS OF AXIS SPECIALTY EUROPE SE (AUSTRALIA BRANCH) TO SWISS RE INTERNATIONAL SE (AUSTRALIA BRANCH) UNDER DIVISION 3A OF PART III OF THE INSURANCE ACT 1973 (Cth) (THE ACT).

TAKE NOTICE that AXIS Specialty Europe SE (Australia Branch) ABN 19 131 203 122 (AXIS) intends to make an application to the Federal Court of Australia in Sydney on 9 February 2017, or on such later date or time as the Court appoints, for confirmation of a scheme to transfer all of the general insurance business of AXIS to Swiss Re International SE (Australia Branch) ABN 58 158 873 211 (Swiss Re) (the Scheme).

AXIS is the Australian branch of AXIS Specialty Europe SE, a company incorporated in Ireland. AXIS is authorised under the Act to carry on general insurance run-off business in Australia. Swiss Re is the Australian branch of Swiss Re International SE, a body corporate incorporated in Luxembourg and authorised under the Act to carry on general insurance business in Australia.

If the Scheme is confirmed, the general insurance business of AXIS will be transferred to Swiss Re and Swiss Re will be substituted for AXIS in all insurance contracts written by AXIS.

Persons who are insured under insurance contracts written by AXIS (Affected Policyholders) may attend the Court hearing and request to be heard by the Court on the application for confirmation of the Scheme.

The hearing will be held at the New South Wales Registry of the Federal Court of Australia. Any affected Policyholder who wishes to appear before the Court or wishes to object to the terms of the Scheme, is requested to advise the solicitor for AXIS, Mark Kimberley of HWL Ebsworth, Level 14 Australia Square, 254-278 George Street, Sydney, Australia (p: +61 2 9334 8793 or e: mark.kimberley@hwl.com.au) at least seven days prior to the hearing date specified above.

Affected Policyholders are not required to take any action if they have no objection to the Scheme.
