HERITAGE WALLING WORKS SUMMARY

South Sydney Hospital Site Heritage Wall Restoration

Heritage Walling Works

The heritage boundary wall on Joynton Avenue (former South Sydney Hospital site) will be raised early next year in advance of roadworks to Joynton Avenue in the second half of 2017.

The works will be undertaken in two stages:

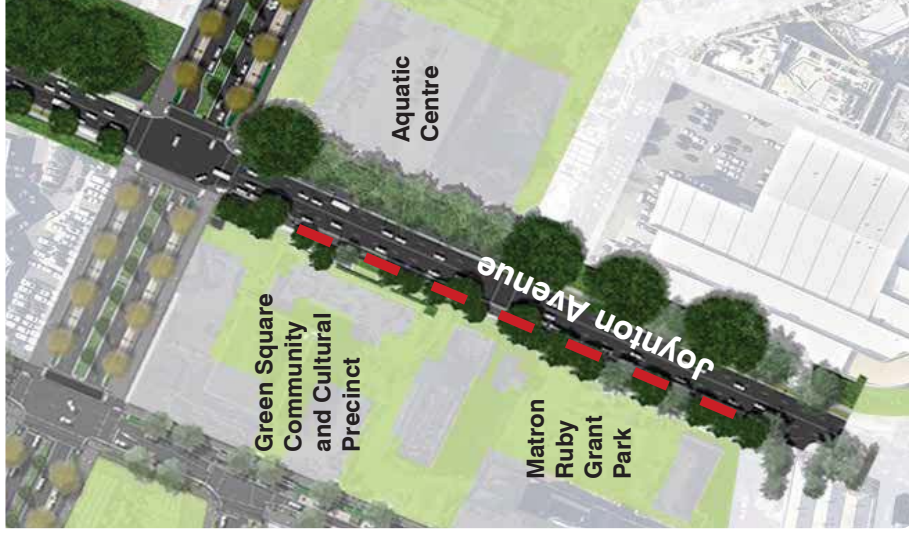
- Stage 1 will include removing the sandstone capping, raising brick courses and a mass concrete retaining structure on the inside of the wall.
- Stage 2 will include reinstatement of the sandstone capping in late 2017 or early 2018.

Detailed restoration and reconstruction of the South Sydney Hospital Heritage Wall along Joynton Avenue will include the following works:

- Restoration and reconstruction of the existing heritage wall including repair of cracking to brickwork and stonework and removal of graffiti
- Removal of existing sandstone capping and raising brickwork
- New sandstone capping will match existing where required
- Short term works to footpath include asphalt overlay and ramps on footpaths, as well as grading of verge to tie into the existing Joynton Avenue footpaths
- Concrete footings, piers and new brickwork for infill works
- Wall strengthening works (below ground footings)

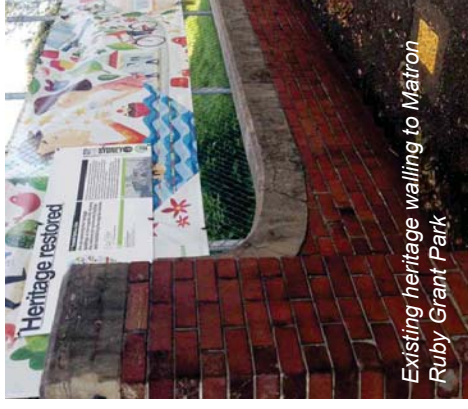


illustrative sketch of proposed Joynton Avenue works (Image Source: AECOM)

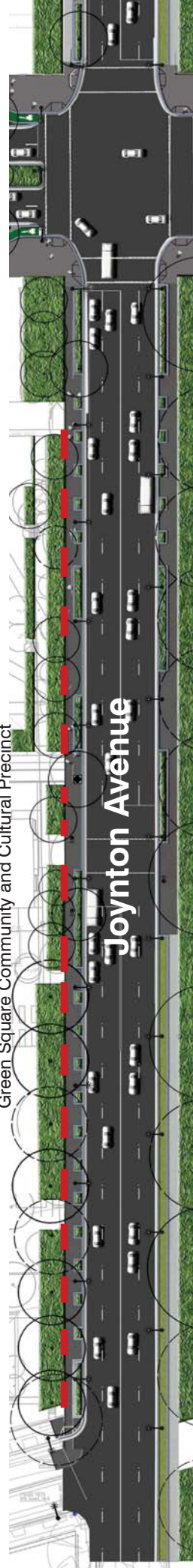
