

**ITEM 10. OVERSEAS TRAVEL REPORT – 100 RESILIENT CITIES NETWORK****FILE NO: S050647****SUMMARY**

The 100 Resilient Cities was launched in 2013 by the Rockefeller Foundation as a \$100 million commitment to build urban resilience. Officials and leaders from over 700 cities applied for the program. The City of Sydney was part of the second round of members in 2014, from among almost 350 applications.

As part of the City of Sydney's membership of the 100 Resilient Cities network, the Lord Mayor was invited by Michael Berkowitz, President of 100 Resilient Cities, to a summit of leaders from the current 67 cities that make up the network.

On 10 August 2015, Council endorsed the Lord Mayor to participate in the summit from Thursday 1 October 2015 to Sunday 4 October 2015.

The Lord Mayor's international travel report has been prepared and is at Attachment A.
