Recommendation

That the Lord Mayor and Councillors note the information contained in this memo.

Purpose

Councillors requested the following additional information regarding contributions the City is making or required to make to public domain works in the vicinity of the Barangaroo development.

Background

In May 2012, Council adopted the Harbour Village North Public Domain Plan. Key projects in the Plan include:

| Barangaroo Integration Works | Joint delivery between Barangaroo Delivery Authority and the City of a series of public domain improvements connecting the new Barangaroo Reserve to the City. The project area includes Munn Reserve, Towns Place, Dalgety Road and Argyle Place. | \$7.3m |
| Argyle Street Improvements | Improvements to pedestrian priority, amenity and legibility along Argyle Street which forms the main route between The Rocks and Barangaroo. Includes creation of local open space in an area of reclaimed road space. | \$4.4m |

| Kent Street Underpass | <p>Improve the pedestrian connection between York/Grosvenor Streets and Kent Street/Barangaroo.</p> <p>Upgrade underutilised public domain spaces to encourage community use.</p> <p>Improve pedestrian way-finding and pedestrian amenity</p> | \$5.0m |
| Gas Lane | Shared way improvements, including paving and lighting. | \$0.8m |

Other projects in design development include the Harbour Village North cycle link, and a separated cycle facility between Sydney Harbour Bridge and Kent Street Underpass.
