Background

Councillors requested a review of the 2007 Open Space and Recreation Needs Study to report on the completion status of the Study's actions and, in the case of any actions yet to be completed, confirm whether they remain relevant and either have been or will be incorporated in the draft 2016 Study.

The draft 2016 Open Space Sport and Recreation Needs Study is essentially a review and update of the 2007 Study.

The 8 strategic directions in the 2007 Study have been incorporated into the 2016 Study with an additional direction on district planning.

The majority of actions in the 2007 Study have been completed or, if still relevant, incorporated into the draft 2016 Study.

The 2007 Study contained some actions that were specific to particular field sports. Unless already actioned, the 2016 Study has taken a more multipurpose approach to the provision of sports fields and has not included actions on use allocations for individual field sports and codes.
