### **ALTERNATIVE RECOMMENDATION**

It is resolved that:

- (A) Council approve the proposal for the establishment of temporary alcohol free zones, ***as shown in Attachment A to the memo dated 9 December 2016 from the Director City Life and circulated prior to the meeting of Council***, for public consultation in accordance with the requirements of the *Local Government Act 1993*; and
- (B) an extraordinary meeting of Council be held on 23 January 2017 to consider the proposal and any submissions made in the consultation period.

### **Background**

In the body of the Officer's Report for this matter, there is a list of proposed Alcohol Free Zones. These zones correlate to the application made by Surry Hills Local Area Command.

Subsequent to the release of the Council Business Paper, two minor discrepancies have been identified in Attachment A to the Officer's Report (Map of proposed Alcohol Free Zones) regarding:

- Renny Lane; and
- Leinster Street (between Regent Street and Bent Street).

These two streets were not requested by Surry Hills Local Area Command for inclusion as Alcohol Free Zones and should not have been included in the map. An amended map is attached to this Relevant To.
