05/07/13	"	Concerned about <b>large trees and poor lighting</b> on George Street.  Do not plant a row of trees along the George Street frontage to the park.  Install lighting at the George Street end of the site.	The large Eucalyptus located in the south western corner of the site (fronting George St) is proposed for removal following the recent failure of a large portion of the canopy.  The removal of these trees will open up the George St frontage of the park.  Low planting is proposed at the George Street end of the site so that site lines are maintained and the site has a welcoming character.
15/07/13	"	Respondent believes the proposed garden area between the playground and community garden will block <b>lines of site</b> .  Do not block lines of site of playground from William St. Do not block lines of site through the park.  Provide north facing <b>seating</b> away from the playground.	Noted.  Lines of site to the playground will not be obscured.  The garden bed between the playground and community garden will contain low shrubs and groundcovers.  A variety of seating opportunities are provided, including bench seat and low height seating walls. These are positioned in a variety of locations to provide seating in sun and shade.
