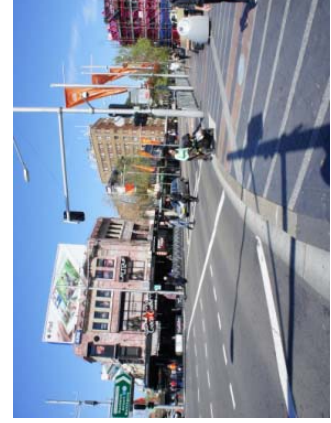

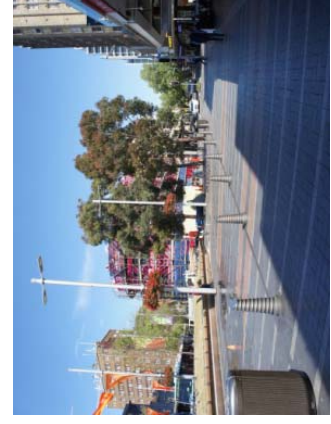

Key Recommendations for possible future improvements



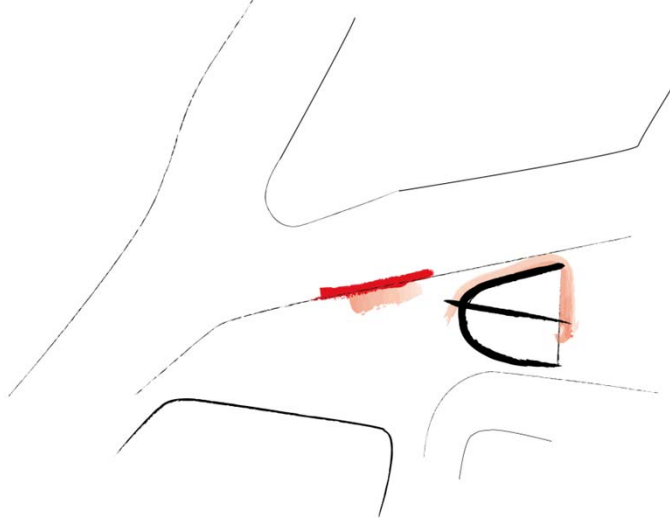
Improved Circulation + Amenity

- Functional circulation for all users
- Improved cycle amenities including -
- Bike parking
- Repair/maintenance stands
- Bike hire facilities
- Linked cycle connectivity strategy



Create a generous "square"

- Remove existing fountain
- Remove existing grass mound
- Create opportunity for improved public domain
- Create cycle gathering space
- Create shared community activity space



A sense of protection

- Create an 'edge' to Flinders St - planting
- Increase warmth of materials
- Increase pedestrian comfort & shade
- Allow an inviting connection to building entry
- Improve passive surveillance
- Consider feature trees to link Taylor Square North & South
