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#### Summary conclusions from intercept survey of smokers and non smokers in **Martin Place**

An intercept survey of 757 pedestrians was conducted to assess the community attitude towards smoking in Martin Place, to determine preferences for smoking prohibitions, and to identify awareness of existing smoking regulations.

The survey did not indicate a strong preference (including from non-smokers) for smoking to be prohibited within Martin Place in entirety or in sections. If smoking were to be prohibited entirely within Martin Place about 38% of smokers predicted that they would relocate to smoke in nearby areas.

Similarly, if smoking were to be prohibited in sections, nearly half of the smokers surveyed predicted that they would move to smoke in the permitted areas. 14% of smokers predicted that they would continue to smoke in the prohibited areas if a prohibition were implanted.



# **Monitoring of Smokers**

### **Intercept Survey**

A 2 minute intercept survey with people at Martin Place, Sydney.

A total of 757 people were interviewed, 358 smokers and 399 non-smokers.

Data is split by smokers and non-smokers and is displayed by counts.

The maximum margin of error for a sample of n=358 is +/- 5.18% at the 95% confidence level.

The maximum margin of error for a sample of n=399 is +/- 4.91% at the 95% confidence level.

The intercept survey was conducted by Xyst.

Fieldwork for the intercept study was also conducted between the 9<sup>th</sup> and the 25<sup>th</sup> of October.

# **Total** (n=2792)



From the 9 days of monitoring, a total of **2,792 smokers were monitored** in Martin Place.


# Time of Day



### **Estimate of Total Smokers - Weekday** (n=2,539)

Average number of smokers counted per 20 minute period: 31

Minimum: 8 Maximum: 54




Based on the observational data, between the hours of 7:00am and 8:40pm the number of smokers on an average weekday is estimated to be **1,305** 

### **Estimate of Total Smokers - Saturday** (n=253)

Average number of smokers counted per 20 minute period: 11

Minimum: 4 Maximum: 18



Based on the observational data, between the hours of 7:00am and 8:40pm the number of smokers on an average Saturday is estimated to be **465**

- 2,083 smokers were monitored in Martin Pl in singles.

#### Presence of Smoking Detering People from Using Martin Place

**7%** of people said **yes**, it deters them from using Martin Place.

88% said no.

5% said don't know.

#### Presence of Smoking Marring Enjoyment of Martin Place

**29%** of people said **yes**, it mars their enjoyment of Martin Place.

67% said no.

4% said don't know.

**Note:** The data for this section has been weighted so that the sample represents equal proportions of smokers and non-smokers to prevent bias.



80% said no.

53% of non-smokers said yes, it mars their enjoyment of Martin Place.

40% said no.

7% said don't know.
