# <u>Wilson Street Cycleway</u>

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Vilson Street, Burren Street, Pine Street, Little Eveleigh Street & Leamington Lane

## ABOUT THIS PROJECT

## Improving Wilson, Burren and Little Eveleigh Streets in Newtown

The City of Sydney invites your feedback on plans to improve Wilson Street, Burren Street, Pine Street, Little scheidpf Street and Learnington Lane in Newdown. These works will enhance safety and improve connections for theophe walking and riding blees between popular destinations.

Works include installing safer pedestrian crossings, separated cycleways, better street lighting and traffic calming measures, as well as more garden beds.

## Pedestrian safety, access and amenity

Improvements include wider footpaths ar intersections and new pedestrian crossings. Shorter crossing distances and better sightlines will create a safet space for pede when withing. Continuous footpath treatments at Prized, Rande Street, Houdsworth Street and Carriageworks Way cain traffic and give priority to people walking. Existing lights will be upgraded and additional lights installed to provide safe. consistent lighting levels

The mature tree canopy along Wilson Street will be improved with more street trees, garden beds and planting. Existing trees have been incorporated into the design with adjustments in the cycleway alignment to avoid large tree trunks and overhanging branches. A total of seven trees will need to be removed to facilitate the works however 18 new trees will be planted along the route. Improvements to Little Eveleigh Street will enhance pedestrian and bike rider connectivity and safety, including widening the contra-flow bicycle lane, discreet improvements to footpath pavements, and the road surface where required, and opportunities for bike parking

### Cycling safety and connections

The proposed works on Wilson Street, Burren Street, Pine Street, Learnington Lane and Little Eveleigh Street will improve safety along important local and regional bike routes between Newtown, the city centre and the eastern suburst.

The project includes a separated one-way cycleway pair running northbound on Burren and southbound on Phra Streets, and a separated two-way cycleway on Wison Street. The nor-way separated cycleways on the eastern side of Phra Street and Burren Street between Albert and Wison Streets with provide safet access for riders to Macdonaldtown Station and Wilson Street.

The proposed cycleway along the south side of Wilson Street will provide protected space for current and new riders and safer intersections for all people who use the street. The bike path in Little Eveleigh Street will be improved, linking to the new Lawson Street cycleway, connecting Redfern and the city

#### Parking spaces

Parking is proposed to be removed on the east side of Burren Street to accommodate the cycleway this will result in the loss of 18 car spaces along this street.

Golden Grove Streets will be converted to parallel parking resulting in the loss of 30 car spaces. Another six car spaces will be removed where required to avoid tree removal and accommodate the cycleway. Parking will remain on both sides of Wilson Street. However, angle parking between Codrington and

Seventeen additional car spaces will be gained along Wilson Street as a result of adjustments to intersections and kerb side garden beds. This will result in an overall net parking loss along the route of 37 spaces.

### Local access changes

To improve safety at the intersection of Eurren and Wilson Streets, vehicles will no longer be able to enter Brocks Lane from Wilson Street heading ware or Burnen Street heading north, Access from Wilson Street heading as still remain via Watkin Street street heading past will remain Access to Brocks Lane from King Street will remain via Watkin Street and Brown Street. These changes will alow for more planting and wider footpaths, improved crossings for pedestrians and more opportunity for seating and outdoor dining.

To improve safety in Learnington Lane, the shared zone will extend to Pine Street [subject to Roads and Maritime formal approvals)

Projected volumes of new residents, workers and commuters to the Carriageworks development site have been noted and accommodated for within the proposal to provide an efficient, safe and visually affractive strestcape.




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
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Location Plan - Scale 1:4500










Macdonaldtown Station Perspective

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





