

**ITEM 44. TRAFFIC TREATMENT - RAISED THRESHOLD RELOCATION -
MACDONALD STREET ERSKINEVILLE**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the relocation of a raised threshold in MacDonald Street, Erskineville, 10 metres east of Goddard Street.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

The developer of the "Erko" development is required to build a new road along the eastern boundary of the railway line. To make way for the new road, the existing raised threshold on MacDonald Street directly east of the railway line is to be relocated 10 metres east of Goddard Street.

COMMENTS

This proposal would help maintain general safety in the area by reducing the speed of traffic travelling along MacDonald Street. This measure is part of the City's commitment to calm traffic and improve residential amenity.

CONSULTATION

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 19 letters sent out with one response supporting the proposal and no responses opposing the proposal.

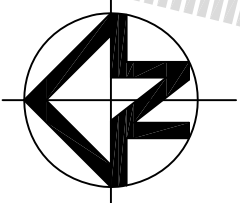
FINANCIAL
