

ITEM 26. PARKING - PERMIT PARKING - WILSON STREET DARLINGTON

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the northern side of Wilson Street, Darlington between the points 12.5 metres and 19.3 metres (1 car space) east of Codrington Street as "1P 8am-10pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 32".

DECISION

BACKGROUND

A resident of Wilson Street has advised that the existing disability space is no longer needed and has requested consideration of permit parking in Wilson Street to meet the current needs of the local residents.

COMMENTS

Part of the kerb space on the northern side of Wilson Street, Darlington between Codrington and Shepherd Streets is currently signposted as "Disability Parking". Consultation undertaken with local residents revealed that this space is no longer needed.

An on-site inspection shows there is a need to provide timed permit parking to increase parking turnover and improve resident access to on-street parking.

The proposed changes would limit any vehicle which does not have a permit to one hour of parking from 8am to 8pm, Monday to Friday where the signs are installed.

Residents with an Area 32 parking permit will be exempt from the 1-hour time limit.

CONSULTATION

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 50 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

FINANCIAL

Funds are available in the current budget.

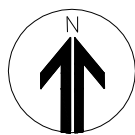
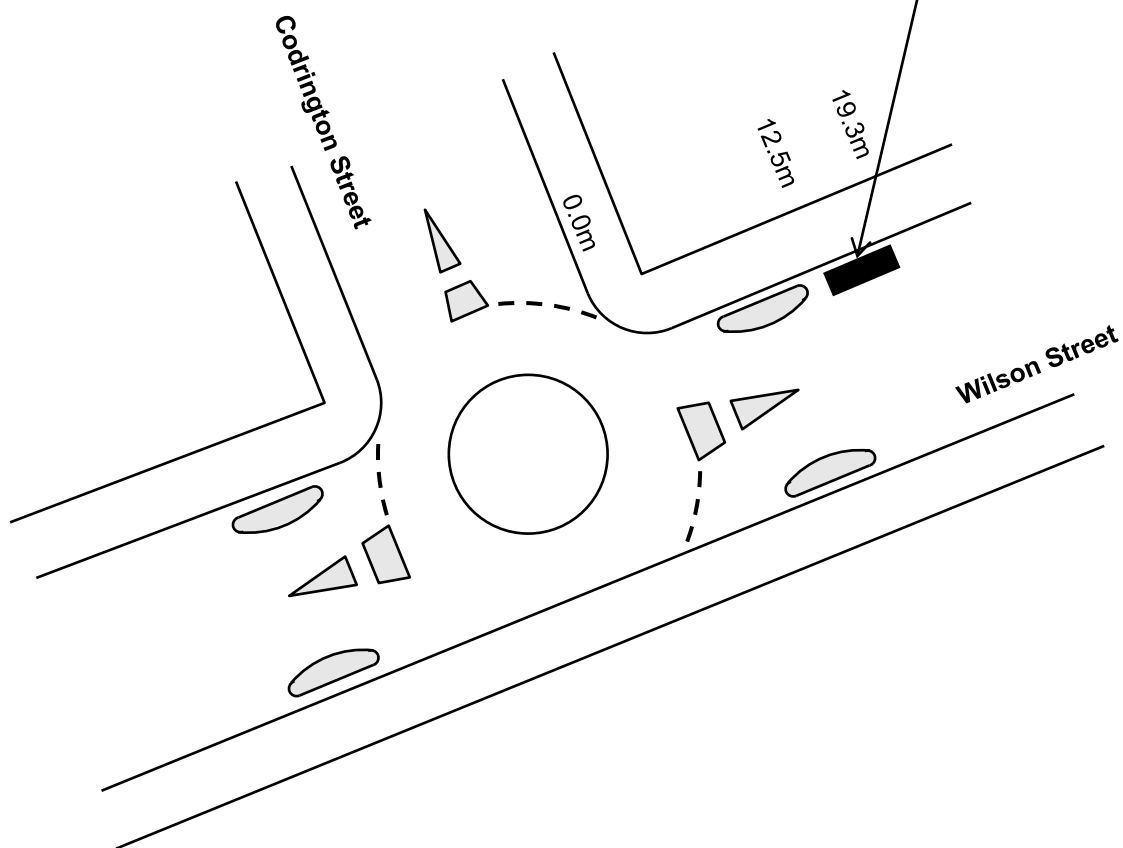
