

**ITEM 29. PARKING - NO PARKING - COPELAND LANE ALEXANDRIA**

**TRIM RECORD NO: 2014/372248**

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the allocation of parking on the southern side of Copeland Lane, Alexandria between the points 0 metres and 16 metres (two car spaces) west of Suttor Street as "No Parking".

**DECISION**

**BACKGROUND**

A resident of Copeland Lane has requested consideration of "No Parking" in Copeland Lane to allow safe vehicular turning movement at the intersection with Suttor Street.

**COMMENTS**

The kerb space on the southern side of Copeland Lane, Alexandria between Suttor and Newton Streets is currently unrestricted for parking.

Copeland Lane is a 4.0 metre wide laneway. Under existing conditions, vehicular turning movements at the intersection of Copeland Lane and Suttor Street are restricted when a vehicle parks in Copeland Lane. The existing conditions force large vehicles to encroach onto adjoining footpaths when making turning movements at the intersection of Copeland Lane and Suttor Street.

An on-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a "No Parking" restriction to improve safety by providing safe turning movement area at the intersection of Copeland Lane and Suttor Street.

**CONSULTATION**

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 38 letters sent out with four responses supporting the proposal and no responses opposing the proposal.

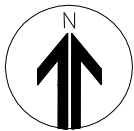
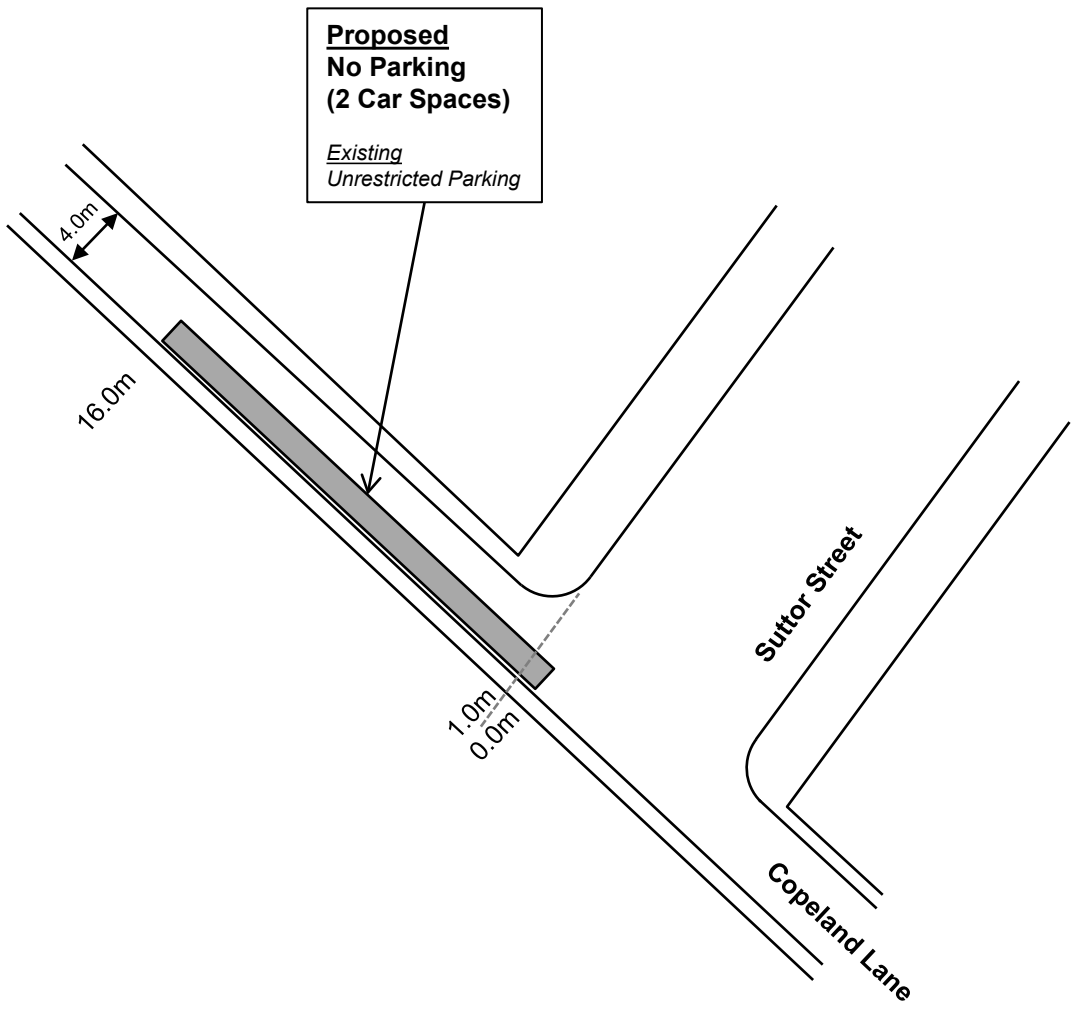
**FINANCIAL**
