

ITEM 32. PARKING - NO STOPPING - QUEEN STREET NEWTOWN

TRIM RECORD NO: 2014/346478

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the allocation of parking on the western side of Queen Street, Newtown between the points 0.0 metres and 10.0 metres south of Bennett Street as “No Stopping”.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

A resident of Bennett Street has requested consideration of “No Stopping” in Queen Street, Newtown to prevent vehicles from being parked close to the intersection and reduce sight distance.

COMMENTS

The kerb space on the western side of Queen Street, Newtown between Bennett and Wilson Streets is currently unrestricted for parking.

An on-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a “No Stopping” restriction to improve safety. This “No Stopping” would comply with the statutory restriction to improve sight distance at the intersection.

CONSULTATION

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 55 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

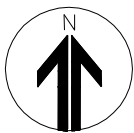
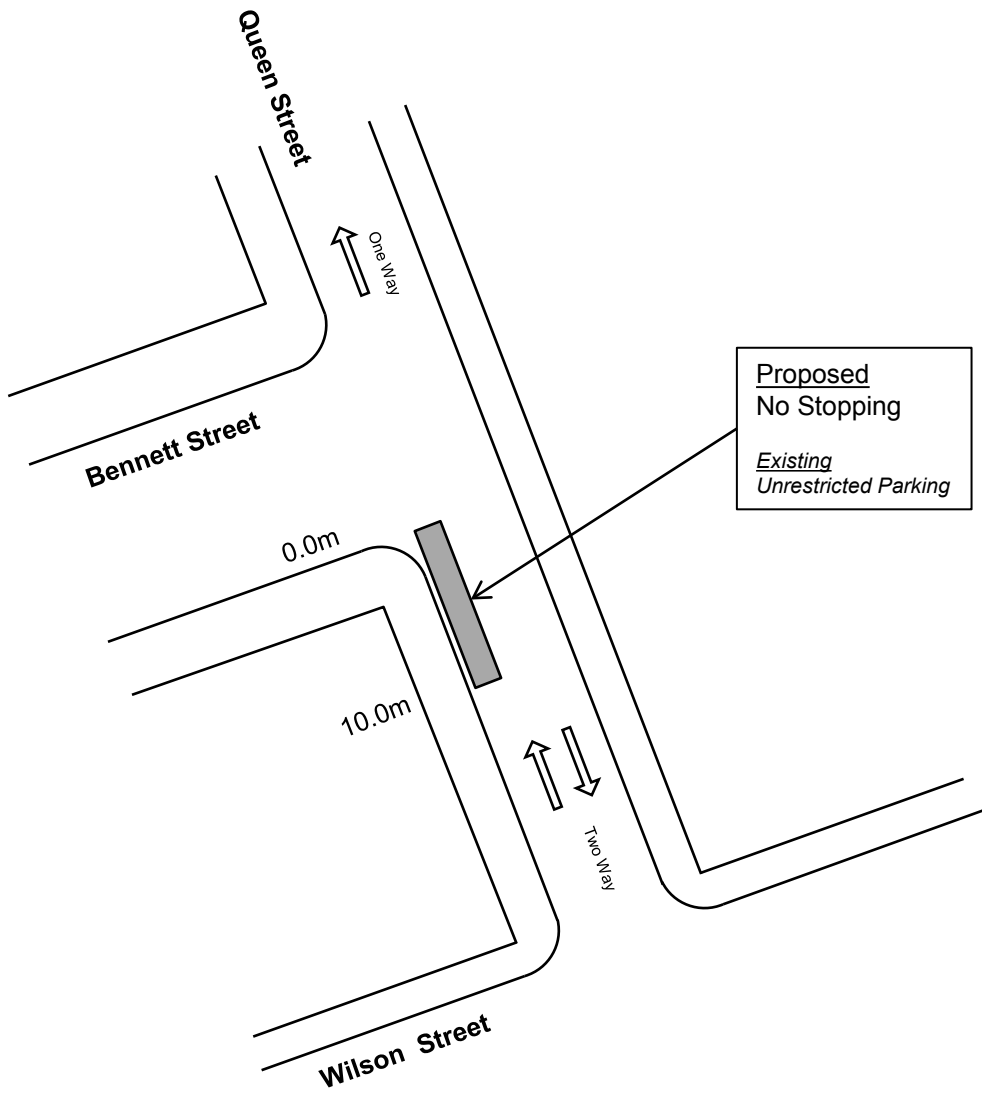
FINANCIAL
