**ITEM 4 ITEM FOR COMMITTEE INFORMATION – SPECIAL EVENT CLEARWAY
 – BANNERMAN CRESCENT ROSEBERY (2014/493184)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee note the allocation of parking on the eastern side of Bannerman Crescent, Rosebery, between the points 10 metres and 157.6 metres north of Asquith Avenue as “Special Event Clearway 6am-7pm” between the 27 and 30 November 2014 for the Australian Open Golf.

To encourage and support the use of public transport to the event, the Transport Management Centre (TMC) will install Special Event Clearways on Bannerman Crescent to provide effective pick-up and drop-off services. The Special Event Clearway will operate from the 27 to 30 November 2014 from 6am to 7pm.

- (F) The Applicant must contact Sydney Buses and arrange and pay for the rerouting of bus services around the closures, the temporary relocation of bus stops and any additional staff required.
- (G) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed closure and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

City Projects, on behalf of CA and I, has applied for the temporary southbound road closure of Crown Street between Cleveland and Devonshire Streets, Surry Hills, from Monday 24 November to Thursday 27 November 2014, between 10pm and 6am.

**ITEM 17 ROAD WORKS – TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – DARLINGTON
LANE DARLINGTON (2014/446011)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the temporary road closure of Darlington Lane, between Codrington Street and Golden Grove Road, Darlington, from Friday 21 November to Monday 24 November 2014, between 7am and 6pm, subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as mentioned in Schedule C of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must comply with any other conditions imposed by City's Construction Regulation Unit.
- (C) The Applicant has indicated 28 November to 1 December 2014 as an additional period for the road works as a contingency for inclement weather.
- (D) The Applicant must contact Newtown Police to obtain a separate police permit and to discuss deployment of user pay police for the road closure.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

John Holland Pty Ltd has applied for the temporary road closure of Darlington Lane, between Codrington Street and Golden Grove Road, Darlington, from Friday 21 November to Monday 24 November 2014, between 7am and 6pm.

**ITEM 18 ROAD WORKS – TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – KENSINGTON
STREET CHIPPENDALE (2014/446694)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the extension of the temporary road closure of Kensington Street, between Outram and Dwyer Streets, Chippendale from 16 December 2014 to 31 March 2015, subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as mentioned in Schedule C of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must comply with any other conditions imposed by City's Construction Regulation Unit.
- (C) The Applicant must contact the Redfern Police to obtain a separate police permit and to discuss deployment of user pay police for the road closure.
- (D) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed closure and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

Frasers Broadway has applied for the extension of the temporary road closure of Kensington Street, between Outram and Dwyer Street, Chippendale from 16 December 2014 to 31 March 2015.

ITEM 19 WORKS ZONE – MITCHELL ROAD ALEXANDRIA (2014/454555)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of the kerb space on the eastern side of Mitchell Road, Alexandria, between the points 34.4 metres and 47.4 metres (two car spaces) north of Fountain Street as “Works Zone 7.30am-5.30pm Mon-Fri, 7.30am-3.30pm Sat”, subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the Works Zone conditions as stipulated in Schedule D of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant is not permitted to swing or hoist goods from a Works Zone across or over any part of a public road by means of a lift, hoist or crane unless a separate approval has been obtained from the City's Building Approvals Unit under Section 68 of the Local Government Act 1993.
- (C) The Applicant must notify local residents of the Works Zone at least seven days prior to installation.
- (D) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the Site Manager.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

3Corp Pty Ltd has applied for a 13 metre long Works Zone in Mitchell Road, Alexandria.

The Works Zone is to facilitate construction works at 74 Mitchell Road for a period of approximately 40 weeks.

ITEM 20 WORKS ZONE – RILEY STREET SURRY HILLS (2014/446868)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of the kerb space on the western side of Riley Street, Surry Hills, between points 10.5 metres and 18.0 metres (one car space) north of Reservoir Street as “Works Zone 7.30am-5.30pm Mon-Fri, 7.30am-3.30pm Sat”, subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the Works Zone conditions as stipulated in Schedule D of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant is not permitted to swing or hoist goods from a Works Zone across or over any part of a public road by means of a lift, hoist or crane unless a separate approval has been obtained from the City's Building Approvals Unit under Section 68 of the Local Government Act 1993.
- (C) The Applicant must notify local residents of the Works Zone at least fourteen days prior to installation.
- (D) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the Site Manager.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

Cumberland Building Pty Ltd has applied for a 7.5 metre long Works Zone in Riley Street, Surry Hills.

The Works Zone is to facilitate construction works at 255-257 Riley Street for a period of approximately 40 weeks.

**ITEM 21 WORKS ZONE – DALMENY AND ROSEBERY AVENUES ROSEBERY
(2014/436723)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of the kerb space as follows:

- On eastern side of Rosebery Avenue, Rosebery, between points 109.3 metres and 184.3 metres (13 car spaces) north of Kimberley Grove as “Works Zone 7.30am-5.30pm Mon-Fri, 7.30am-3.30pm Sat”.
- On eastern side of Rosebery Avenue, Rosebery, between points 213.8 metres and 247.8 metres (six car spaces) north of Kimberley Grove as “Works Zone 7.30am-5.30pm Mon-Fri, 7.30am-3.30pm Sat”.
- On western side of Dalmeny Avenue, Rosebery between points 181 metres and 216 metres (six car spaces) north of Kimberley Grove as “Works Zone 7.30am-5.30pm Mon-Fri, 7.30am-3.30pm Sat”.

Subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the Works Zone conditions as stipulated in Schedule D of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant is not permitted to swing or hoist goods from a Works Zone across or over any part of a public road by means of a lift, hoist or crane unless a separate approval has been obtained from the City's Building Approvals Unit under Section 68 of the Local Government Act 1993.
- (C) The Applicant must notify local residents of the Works Zone at least seven days prior to installation.
- (D) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the Site Manager.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

Karimbla Construction Services (NSW) Pty Ltd has applied for three Works Zones along both frontages of their site. Approval is sought for two Works Zones in Rosebery Avenue (one 75 metres and one 34 metres) and one in Dalmeny Avenue (35 metres).

The Works Zones are to facilitate construction works at 94-102 Dalmeny Avenue for a period of approximately 26 weeks.

**ITEM 22 PARKING – DISABILITY PARKING – REUSS STREET GLEBE
(2013/366302)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the southern side of Reuss Street, Glebe, between the points 15 metres and 20 metres west of Purves Street as “1P 8am-10pm Permit Holders Excepted Area G, Disability Parking Only Other Times” (1 car space).

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

A resident has requested a disability parking space in Reuss Street, Glebe. The resident has advised they are not in a wheelchair but cannot physically walk far.

ITEM 23 PARKING – MUNNI STREET ERSKINEVILLE (2011/180627)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation parking of the southern side of Munni Street Erskineville, between the points 14.6 metres and 19.6 metres (1 car space) east of Union Street as unrestricted parking.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

GoGet has requested the removal of a Car Share space on the southern side of Munni Street Erskineville, east of Union Street. The kerb space will return to unrestricted parking.

**ITEM 24 PARKING – NO PARKING – MITCHELL LANE ALEXANDRIA
(2014/436442)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the allocation of parking on the western side of Mitchell Lane, Alexandria between the points 61 metres and 68 metres (1 car space) south of Brown Street as “No Parking”.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

A resident of Mitchell Lane has requested consideration of “No Parking” to ensure unobstructed access to their rear off-street parking.

ITEM 25 PARKING – QUARRY STREET ULTIMO (2014/273254)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the eastern side of Quarry Street, Ultimo between the points 54.7 metres and 90.7 metres (6 car spaces) north of Wattle Street as “No Parking 8am-9.30am 2.30pm-3.30pm Mon-Fri”, “2P Ticket 9.30am-2.30pm 3.30pm-7pm Mon-Fri 8am-7pm Sat-Sun Permit Holders Excepted Area 14”.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

Ultimo Public School in Quarry Street has requested consideration of six parking spaces at the northern end of Quarry Street to facilitate the picking up and dropping off of students.

**ITEM 26 PARKING – PERMIT PARKING – ASHMORE MALCOLM AND BINNING
STREETS ERSKINEVILLE (2014/360480)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the allocation of the following parking in Erskineville as “2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area 40”:

- (A) Southern side of Ashmore Street between the points 10 metres and 82 metres (12 car spaces), 87 metres and 142 metres (nine car spaces) and 148 metres and 154 metres (one car space), east of Bridge Street;
- (B) Northern side of Ashmore Street between the points 10 metres and 24 metres (two car spaces), east of Bridge Street;
- (C) Northern side of Ashmore Street between the points 10 metres and 24 metres (two car spaces), east of Malcolm Lane;
- (D) Northern side of Ashmore Street between the points 10 metres and 24 metres (two car spaces), east of Malcolm Street;
- (E) Northern side of Ashmore Street between the points 10 metres and 24 metres (two car spaces), east of Binning Lane;
- (F) Western side of Malcolm Street between the points 10 metres and 70 metres (10 car spaces), north of Ashmore Street;
- (G) Eastern side of Malcolm Street between the points 10 metres and 188 metres (30 car spaces), north of Ashmore Street, as “2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area 40”;
- (H) Eastern side of Malcolm Street between the points 10 metres and 28 metres (three car spaces), north of Swanson Lane;
- (I) Western side of Binning Street between the points 10 metres and 187 metres (29 car spaces), north of Ashmore Street;
- (J) Eastern side of Binning Street between the points 10 metres and 108 metres (16 car spaces), south of Elliott Avenue; and
- (K) Eastern side of Binning Street between the points 10 metres and 67 metres (nine car spaces), north of Elliott Avenue.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously and noted that the Representative for the Member for Heffron, Darren Jenkins, declared a conflict of interest for this item as he is also the President of the local resident action group, Friends of Erskineville, which is active in Ashmore, Binning and Malcolm Streets, Erskineville.

BACKGROUND

In November 2011, the City consulted with residents in Ashmore, Malcolm and Binning Streets, Erskineville asking for support for the introduction of timed permit parking as part of the Alexandria Parking Trial.

At that time, residents in the streets did not support the timed permit parking proposal. It was noted that the City would monitor parking conditions in the streets and reconsider the permit parking proposal if there was strong support from residents in the future.

In August 2014, the City received petitions signed by residents of 18 properties in Ashmore Street, 35 properties in Malcolm Street and 43 properties requesting consideration for timed permit parking in Ashmore, Malcolm and Binning Streets, Erskineville.

ITEM 27 PARKING – PERMIT PARKING – DARGHAN LANE GLEBE (2014/429000)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the allocation of parking on Darghan Lane west of Cardigan Street as follows;

- (A) On the southern side between the points 10 metres and 35 metres (4 car spaces) as “2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area G”; and
- (B) On the northern side between the points 10 metres and 35 metres as “No Stopping”.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

The City received a petition from residents requesting the introduction of permit parking in Darghan Lane between Cardigan Street and Railway Street, Glebe.

**ITEM 28 PARKING – PERMIT PARKING – PLEASANT AVENUE ERSKINEVILLE
(2014/416681)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the allocation of parking in Pleasant Avenue, Erskineville as follows:-

- A) On the western side between points 25.6 metres and 117 metres (24 car spaces) south of Victoria Street as “2P 8am-10pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 36”.
- B) On the eastern side between points 25.6 metres and 117 metres (24 car spaces) south of Victoria Street as “2P 8am-10pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 36”.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

In September 2014, the City received a petition signed by residents of 30 properties requesting consideration for permit parking in Pleasant Avenue, Erskineville.

Pleasant Avenue is a cul-de-sac local street with low residential traffic volume and there is a high demand for parking in the street. 90° angled parking has been operating successfully on both sides of the streets for many years without any reported incidents.

**ITEM 29 PARKING – PERMIT PARKING – RAILWAY STREET GLEBE
(2014/429000)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the following parking allocations on Railway Street, Glebe as follows:

- (A) On the northern side between the points 46.3 metres and 103.9 metres (9 car spaces) west of Bellevue Street as “2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area G”;
- (B) On the northern side between the points 10.3 metres and 62.5 metres (8 car spaces) west of Darling Street as “2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area G”;
- (C) On the southern side between the points 10 metres and 20.1 metres (2 car spaces) west of Bellevue Street as “2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area G”;
- (D) On the southern side between the points 10.5 metres and 20.8 metres (2 car spaces) west of Darling Street as “2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area G”; and
- (E) On the southern side between the points 10 metres and 24.5 metres (2 car spaces) west of Broughton Street as “2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area G”.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

The City is proposing to introduce permit parking restrictions into the unrestricted parking area on Railway Street, Glebe between Bellevue Street and Bridge Road.

**ITEM 30 PARKING – PERMIT PARKING – WENTWORTH STREET GLEBE
(2014/106399)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the allocation of parking on Wentworth Street Glebe, east of Cowper Street, as follows:

- (A) On the northern side between the points 19 metres and 114.4 metres (19 car spaces) as “2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area G”; and
- (B) On the southern side between the points 10 metres and 65.8 metres (9 car spaces) and between 114.6 metres and 121.9 metres (2 car space) as “2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area G”.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

A resident of Cowper Street has requested consideration of permit parking in Wentworth Avenue.

The unrestricted parking in Wentworth Street is currently used by commuters and transient motorists for long term parking. This reduces the available kerbspace for residents.

**ITEM 31 PARKING – UNRESTRICTED PARKING – UNION STREET NEWTOWN
(2014/390103)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the western side of Union Street, Newtown between the points 73.3 metres and 79.3 metres (1 car space) north of Knight Street as unrestricted for parking.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

A resident of Union Street has advised that the existing disability space is no longer needed and has requested consideration of unrestricted parking in Union Street to meet the current needs of the residents.

ITEM 32 PARKING – WOOLLEY STREET GLEBE (2014/388168)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on Woolley Street, Glebe as follows:

- (A). On the northern side of Woolley Street, west of St James Lane:
- Between points 4.2 metres and 16.2 metres as “No Parking 8am-6pm Wedding and Funeral Vehicles Excepted”
 - Between points 16.2 metres and 33.5 metres as “P10 Minutes 8am-9am 2.30pm-3.30pm School Days” and “1P 9am-2.30pm 3.30pm-6pm School Days”.
 - Between points 51.5 metres and 95.4 metres as “P10 Minutes 8am-9am 2.30pm-3.30pm School Days” and “1P 9am-2.30pm 3.30pm-6pm School Days”.
- (B). On the southern side of Woolley Street, west of Woolley Lane between points 29 metres and 34 metres as “No Parking Authorised Car Share Vehicles Excepted”

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

St James Catholic Primary School on Woolley Street, Glebe has requested changes to parking in the street to improve the drop off and pick up of students attending the school.

The St James Catholic Church has also requested parking for wedding and funeral vehicles in front of the entrance to the church.

ITEM 33 CAR SHARE – JONES STREET ULTIMO (2014/471495)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the western side of Jones Street, Ultimo between the points 51.0 metres and 56.0 metres (1 car space) north of Quarry Street as “No Parking Car Share Vehicles Excepted” subject to the following:

- (A) The City will only install signage for the car share space when GoGet has a car to occupy the space.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

The City is committed to providing dedicated parking for car sharing across the Local Government Area as part of a Council approved Car Share Policy. A submission has been received from GoGet for a car share space in Jones Street, north of Quarry Street.

ITEM 34 CAR SHARE – ST JOHNS ROAD GLEBE (2014/471517)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the southern side of St Johns Road, Glebe between the points 10.0 metres and 15.0 metres (1 car space) west of Broughton Street as “No Parking Car Share Vehicles Excepted” subject to the following:

- (A) The City will only install signage for the car share space when GoGet has a car to occupy the space.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

The City is committed to providing dedicated parking for car sharing across the Local Government Area as part of a Council approved Car Share Policy. A submission has been received from GoGet for a car share space in St Johns Road, Glebe, west of Broughton Street.

ITEM 35 CAR SHARE – VICTORIA ROAD GLEBE (2014/471541)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the allocation of parking on the northern side of Victoria Road, Glebe between the points 20.2 metres and 25.2 metres (1 car space) east of Maxwell Road as “No Parking Car Share Vehicles Excepted” subject to the following:

- (A) The City will only install signage for the car share space when GoGet has a car to occupy the space.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

The City is committed to providing dedicated parking for car sharing across the Local Government Area as part of a Council approved Car Share Policy. A submission has been received from GoGet for a car share space in Victoria Road, Glebe, east of Maxwell Road.

**ITEM 36 TRAFFIC TREATMENT – PROPOSED STREET UPGRADE – KINGS
CROSS ROAD POTTS POINT (2014/264990)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the installation of the following traffic treatments in Kings Cross Road subject to the Roads and Maritime Services approving the updated TCS plan for the proposed changes to the signalised intersection of Kings Cross Road and Darlinghurst Road, Potts Point:

- (A) Widening the footpath on the southern side of Kings Cross Road between Darlinghurst Road and the point 41 metres east of Darlinghurst Road;
- (B) Increased size of the traffic island on the northern side of Kings Cross Road between the points 54 metres and 68 meters east of Darlinghurst Road; and
- (C) A Continuous Footpath Treatment over Pennys Lane.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

In 2012 the Élan Owners Corporation presented a proposal to the City outlining conceptual ideas to provide rain gardens, green walls, formalised indented parking bay to improve passenger vehicle drop-offs and other landscaping ideas to improve the appearance of the building forecourt and in Darlinghurst Road.

ITEM 37 TRAFFIC TREATMENT – MACQUARIE STREET SYDNEY (2014/401541)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the following changes in Macquarie Street, Sydney, north of Bridge Street:

- A) The installation of one trafficable northbound and two trafficable southbound lanes on Macquarie Street between Bridge Street and the signal controlled pedestrian crossing on Macquarie Street;
- B) The reallocation of parking on the eastern side of Macquarie Street between the points 50 metres and 169 metres north of Bridge Street as “No Stopping 7am-10pm Coaches Excepted 15 Minute Limit”;
- C) The reallocation of parking on the eastern side of Macquarie Street between the points 169 metres and 184 metres north of Bridge Street as “No Stopping Sydney and Bondi Explorer Buses Excepted 5 Minute Limit”;
- D) The reallocation of parking on the eastern side of Macquarie Street between the points 340 metres and 403.3 metres (10 car spaces) north of Bridge Street as “Taxi Zone”; and
- E) The permanent closure of the indented bay on the eastern side of Macquarie Street, north of the signal-controlled pedestrian crossing.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

In response to ongoing concerns from local residents and businesses about traffic, parking and road safety issues in Macquarie Street, the City, in conjunction with Transport for NSW, Roads and Maritime Services and the Sydney Opera House, proposes the following improvements:

- One northbound and two southbound travel lanes between Bridge Street and the signal-controlled pedestrian crossing – this change will enable the provision of a full-time dedicated parking lane along the eastern kerb of Macquarie Street;
- A dedicated full-time “Taxi Zone” in the existing indented bay along the eastern kerb of Macquarie Street just south of the Sydney Opera House roundabout;
- Dedicated coach parking along the eastern kerb of Macquarie Street between Bridge Street and the signalised-controlled pedestrian crossing; and
- Permanent closure of the existing indented bay on the eastern side of Macquarie Street, just north of the signal-controlled pedestrian crossing.

The original proposal circulated to local residents and businesses in September 2014 included consideration for changing some of the existing five minute parking on the western side of Macquarie Street to “No Parking”. At the conclusion of the consultation

period this component of the proposed changes was not widely supported by respondents and as such will not proceed.

**ITEM 38 OTHER AUTHORITIES – TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CHANGES – SHELLEY
STREET SYDNEY (2014/490141)**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the following temporary traffic changes:

- Temporary closure of Shelley Street between Lime Street and Sussex Street until 30 September 2015.
- Temporary installation of a turnaround area on Shelley Street, between Erskine Street and Lime Street until 30 September 2015.
- Temporary conversion of Shelley Street to one-way south between the temporary turnaround area and Lime Street.

Subject to following conditions:

- A) The Applicant must carry out notification to affected tenants, occupants and building managements at least one week prior to the commencement of the road closures, and to resolve, to the satisfaction of the City, any issues that may arise and all representations made by affected tenants and occupants.
- B) The Applicant must obtain written agreement from all affected car park operators for the proposed closure, and indemnify the Barangaroo Delivery Authority, City of Sydney and the Local Pedestrian, Cycling and Traffic Calming Committee against all claims of revenue loss as a result of the road closure.
- C) The Applicant must place an advertisement in a Sydney metropolitan newspaper at least 7 days before the closure.
- D) All costs associated to the works are to be borne between by the Barangaroo Delivery Authority, Lend Lease and Transport for NSW.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously subject to:

- Barangaroo Delivery Authority (BDA) preparing and submitting a Traffic Management Plan (TMP) for the temporary one-way conversion in Shelley Street, north of Erskine Street, to the RMS; and
- Barangaroo Delivery Authority (BDA) gaining approval from the RMS for the Traffic Management Plan (TMP) for the temporary one-way conversion in Shelley Street, north of Erskine Street.

BACKGROUND

Shelley Street north of Erskine Street is under the jurisdiction of the Barangaroo Delivery Authority (BDA).

The first occupation of Barangaroo South is planned for July 2015. Wynyard Walk Bridge is an important element of the public domain providing pedestrian access from Wynyard

Station to Barangaroo South. The bridge was originally planned to be delivered in time for the first occupation of Barangaroo South. Significant delays have been experienced to the Wynyard Walk Project following a fire that occurred within the Barangaroo South construction site in March 2014. The delivery of a slip road to maintain traffic on Shelley Street during construction was initially part of the Wynyard Walk scope. The proposed closure of Shelley Street aims to recover the original program following the delays caused by the fire by not building this slip road and proceeding directly to building the bridge.

The northern section of Shelley Street between Lime Street and Sussex Street is currently closed following the approval of a Road Occupancy Licence (ROL) by the Roads and Maritime Services' (RMS) Transport Management Centre (TMC) in June 2014. The approval will lapse on 16 November 2014. This submission seeks to extend the current closure of this section of Shelley Street together with network adjustments for the duration of construction of Wynyard Walk Bridge, which is expected to be complete by September 2015.

Due to recent stakeholder concerns in relation to the constrained access to the car park under the 1 Shelley Street building, it is proposed to reopen a short section of Shelley Street to northbound traffic, providing a turnaround area approximately halfway between the intersections of Shelley Street with Erskine Street and Lime Street (See Attachment A). The proposed turnaround would make use of the existing road reserve, shifting the existing taxi ranks to the south to accommodate the turnaround area. The total number of taxi bays will be retained at 5. The existing No Parking area would be removed in order to retain the two 5 minute car parking bays currently in place. The section of the street between the turnaround and the Lime Street intersection would become one way southbound.

- (E) Northern side of Huntley Street between the points 45 metres and 60 metres (two car spaces) east of Euston Road, Alexandria.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously.

BACKGROUND

Bus route 348 currently operates from Bondi Junction to Wolli Creek and return on weekdays only.

Transport for New South Wales (TfNSW) is extending the service for route 348 to a seven day a week service. This is to provide better public transport options through the Rosebery, Beaconsfield and Alexandria area.

As part of the service extension, TfNSW has requested parking restriction changes in Rosebery, Beaconsfield and Alexandria to allow buses to stop during weekends.

All Special Event Clearway (SEC), Bus Lane and Taxi Zone signage will be installed by the Roads & Maritime Services (RMS) service providers.
