**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Committee note the proposed installation of a pedestrian crossing across the western leg of the Victoria and Burton Streets signalised intersection in Darlinghurst.

**DECISION**

**BACKGROUND**

The City East Pedestrian Cycling and Traffic Calming (PCTC) Plan adopted in 2010 included a proposal to install a pedestrian crossing across the western leg of Victoria and Burton Streets signalised intersection in Darlinghurst.

**COMMENTS**

The installation will improve pedestrian safety and connectivity at the intersection of Victoria and Burton Streets, Darlinghurst.

The Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) is the consent authority for all traffic signals and they must give support to any proposed change to traffic signals. In January 2015, the RMS accepted and approved the proposed changes to the signalised intersection.

**CONSULTATION**

Consultation is not required as RMS is the consent authority for traffic signal sites.

**FINANCIAL**

Funds are available in the current budget as part of the City's Capital Works program.
