### ITEM 6. STREET EVENTS – TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – 2015 ANZAC DAY MARCH

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the temporary road closures associated with the Anzac Day Parade on Saturday 25 April 2015 subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closures conditions as stipulated in Schedule B of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must contact the Sydney City Police to discuss deployment of user pay police for the event.
- (C) The Applicant must seek separate approval from the City's Venue Management Unit for the event and use of Martin Place.
- (D) The Applicant is to obtain a Road Occupancy Licence from the Transport Management Centre prior to the event.
- (E) The Applicant must submit a Traffic Control Plan for approval prior to the road closure.
- (F) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed event and include contact details in the notification letters to affected stakeholders.

## DECISION

#### BACKGROUND

The Returned and Services League of Australia has applied for temporary road closures associated with the Anzac Day Parade on Saturday 25 April 2015.

#### COMMENTS

The NSW Department of Premiers and Cabinet coordinate meetings between Transport Authorities (RMS, Sydney Buses, Sydney Trains, and Transport for NSW), Emergency Services, Councils, the NSW Taxi Council and Event organisers to plan for the Annual Anzac Day March.

It should be noted that in late 2015 through to 2019, there will be major road works on George Street, Alfred Street, Rawson Place and Chalmers Street associated with the CBD and South East Light Rail project. This will impact on next year's event as sections of the route may not be available. All event organisers need to review their future event

route and form-up areas in consultation with the City, Police, Transport for NSW, Transport Management Centre and RMS.

Assembly points for participants will be provided in Pitt Street north and south of Martin Place, in Castlereagh, Phillip and King Streets from Queens Square to Pitt Street and in St James Road from Queens Square to Elizabeth Street.

Traffic will be able to use Macquarie and College Streets, Bent Street from Macquarie to O'Connell Streets, the whole of Bligh and O'Connell Streets and Chifley Square to bypass the proposed temporary road closures.

#### Route and Time of Event

The event will commence at 9am with participants walking along Pitt Street, through Martin Place and then along George, Bathurst, Elizabeth and Liverpool Streets before finishing at 1pm at the War Memorial in Hyde Park South for a Commemoration Service.

There are a number of smaller service unit commemorative marches that will take place both prior to and after the main Anzac Day March, but conflict between these events will not occur.


The Applicant will need to seek separate approval from the City's Greening and Leisure Unit for the use of Martin Place and Hyde Park South.
