

ITEM 23. PARKING – NO PARKING – NORTON STREET GLEBE

TRIM RECORD NO: 2015/053892

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the southern side of Norton Street, Glebe between the points 8 metres and 19 metres (2 car spaces) east of Glebe Street as “No Parking”.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

Local residents have requested consideration of introducing “No Parking” restrictions in Norton Street between Glebe Street and Broughton Lane to facilitate unobstructed through traffic flow in Norton Street.

COMMENTS

Both sides of Norton Street between Glebe Street and Broughton Lane are currently unrestricted for parking, and the street width is approximately 6 metres.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a 'No Parking' restriction on the southern of the street to provide unobstructed traffic flow in Norton Street. Similar parking restrictions exist in other sections of Norton Street.

CONSULTATION

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 48 letters sent out with one response supporting the proposal and no response objecting the proposal.

The respondent has stated that the proposed parking change will improve safety to vehicles using the street.

FINANCIAL

Funds are available in the current budget.
