

**ITEM 4.           ITEM FOR COMMITTEE INFORMATION – PARKING SIGN  
REMOVAL – BEACONSFIELD LANE BEACONSFIELD**

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Committee note the proposed removal of the “No Parking” and “No Stopping” signs on the western side of Beaconsfield Lane, Beaconsfield between the points 0 metres and 9.5 metres (2 car spaces), south of Reserve Street.

**DECISION**

**BACKGROUND**

Development Consent Condition 12 of Development Application D/2011/1567/B requires the Developer of 91 Victoria Street, Beaconsfield to refer any traffic and parking changes on the street frontages to the Committee for consideration.

The traffic and parking arrangement plans are to be reviewed by the City before referral to the Committee for consideration.

**COMMENTS**

The existing signs are located within the proposed driveway and require removal for the construction of driveway. The signs will not be reinstated as there are no parking changes to Beaconsfield Lane, Beaconsfield.

Under the Australian Road Rules, the “No Parking” restriction applies across driveways and the “No Stopping” restriction applies to prohibit parking within 10 metres of an intersection. Signs are not required for these restrictions to be enforced.

The proposal will reduce visual clutter and improve amenity for the laneway.

**CONSULTATION**

Consultation is not required as there are no changes to parking restrictions.

**FINANCIAL**

All cost associated with the proposal will be borne by the Developer.
