ITEM 6. ITEM FOR COMMITTEE INFORMATION – UPDATED SIGNPOSTING AND LINE MARKING - CROWN STREET SURRY HILLS BETWEEN CLEVELAND AND DEVONSHIRE STREETS

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee note the attached line marking and sign posting as installed on Crown Street as part of the upgrade between Cleveland and Devonshire Streets.

#### **DECISION**

### **BACKGROUND**

A comprehensive streetscape upgrade was endorsed by Council on 26th August 2013 for Crown Street, Surry Hills between Cleveland and Devonshire Streets. This upgrade aimed to improve pedestrian amenity and to activate the street with more opportunities for street dining and improve street planting.

#### **COMMENTS**

The Local Pedestrian, Cycling and Traffic Calming Committee (LPCTCC) endorsed in principle the signposting and line marking for the Crown Street streetscape upgrade between Cleveland and Devonshire Streets at its meeting in September 2013.

Line marking and signposting changes have now been completed (after further community consultation) and the following changes have been made:

- Relocation of 15 minute parking from outside 573 565 Crown Street to outside the 577 – 573 Crown Street, ie the Surry Hills Medical Centre,
- Relocation of a Loading Zone from outside 577 573 Crown Street to outside 573 - 565 Crown Street,
- Relocation of GoGet car share space from outside 543 Crown Street to 559 Crown Street.
- Relocation of Mail Zone to outside 543 Crown Street (ie adjacent to the Post boxes).

#### CONSULTATION

A public exhibition was undertaken in May 2013 with 6400 letters sent to local residents and businesses, on-line updates and public community forum.

A further consultation was undertaken on the changes identified above and 1200 letters were sent out to residents and businesses along Crown Street. The City received one (1) response supporting the relocation of 15 minute parking and Loading Zone but did not support the relocation of the GoGet car space.

The relocation of the car share space provides a more suitable location which allows the kerbspace to be better allocated to service the needs of the nearby businesses.
