ITEM 7. STREET EVENTS – TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – 2015 AROMA COFFEE FESTIVAL

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the temporary road closures associated with the 2015 Aroma Coffee Festival from 5pm on Saturday 25 July to 11pm Sunday 26 July 2015 subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as stipulated in Schedule B of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must contact the Sydney City Police to discuss deployment of user pay police for the event.
- (C) The Applicant must contact the City's Venue Management Unit to discuss the event.
- (D) The Applicant must obtain a Road Occupancy Licence (ROL) from the Transport Management Centre prior to commencement of works.
- (E) The Applicant must contact Sydney Buses and arrange and pay for the rerouting of bus services around the closures, the temporary relocation of bus stops and any additional staff required.
- (F) The Applicant must submit a Traffic Control Plan for approval prior to the temporary road closures.
- (G) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed event and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

Sydney Harbour Foreshore Authority (SHFA) has applied for the temporary road closures of George Street and Hickson Road for the 2015 Aroma Coffee Festival.

The event will be held on Sunday 26 July from 10am to 5pm however the temporary road closures are required from 5pm on Saturday 25 July to 11pm Sunday 26 July 2015.

COMMENTS

The Aroma Coffee Festival is an annual event that requires the temporary closure of City streets and traffic detours around the event.

Temporary Road Closures – From 5pm on Saturday 25 July to 11pm on Sunday 26 July 2015

- George Street between Alfred and Lower Fort Streets (Hickson Road to Lower Fort Street already closed for The Rocks Markets)
- Hickson Road from George Street to Upper Deck Road of Overseas Passenger Terminal

On Saturday evenings, the City closes George Street at Alfred Street as part of the managed access trial. To avoid conflict with the temporary road closures for Aroma Coffee Festival, the managed access trial will be removed for Saturday 25 July 2015, but will still be required on Friday 24 July 2015.

User pay police will manage the temporary road closures in George and Alfred Streets, and Hickson and Upper Deck Roads for the duration of the event. In addition, RMS Authorised Traffic Controllers will also be stationed at all temporary road closures for the event.

The Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) will be responsible for installing Special Event Clearway signage for the event.

There are currently no other approved temporary road closures proposed to take place on the same day.

CONSULTATION

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders as stipulated in Schedule B.

FINANCIAL


All costs associated with the proposed closures will be borne by the Applicant.


