ITEM 11. ROAD WORKS – TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – LITTLE HAY STREET HAYMARKET

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the temporary road closure of Little Hay Street, between Dixon Street and Harbour Street, Haymarket, from Thursday 23 July 2015 to Monday 3 August 2015 between the hours of 7am to 5pm Mon–Thur, 7am to 1pm Fri and 7am to 5pm Sat, subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as mentioned in Schedule C of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must comply with any other conditions imposed by City's Construction Regulation Unit.
- (C) The Applicant has indicated Tuesday 4 August 2015 to Friday 14 August 2015 as an additional period for the road works as a contingency for inclement weather.
- (D) The Applicant must contact the Sydney City Police to obtain a separate police permit and to discuss deployment of user pay police for the road closures.
- (E) The temporary road closure of Kimber Lane, between Hay and Little Hay Streets, Haymarket for one day during these works.
- (F) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed closures and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

Hindmarsh Construction Australia has applied for the temporary road closure of Little Hay Street, between Dixon Street and Harbour Street, Haymarket, from Thursday 23 July 2015 to Monday 3 August 2015 between the hours of 7am to 5pm Monday-Thursday, 7am to 1pm on Fridays and 7am to 5pm on Saturdays.

COMMENTS

The proposed temporary road closure is required to upgrade the water main between Dixon and Harbour Streets as part of Sydney Water Infrastructure Improvement program.

The proposed closure on Fridays between 7am and 1pm do not impact on the Chinatown Night Market which operates between 4pm and 11pm on Fridays.

The Applicant has provided a site-specific Traffic Control Plan that includes details of barricades, signs, flagmen and other traffic devices to implement the proposed road closure.

There are currently no other approved temporary road closures proposed to take place on the same day in close proximity of this closure.

The temporary road closure will not affect any other properties, as local access will be provided at all times and alternative access routes are available nearby.

CONSULTATION

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders as stipulated in Schedule C.


FINANCIAL


