

**ITEM 27. PARKING CHANGE - HARMER STREET WOOLLOOMOOLOO**

**TRIM RECORD NO: 2015/155101**

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of the following parking on the northern side of Harmer Street, Woolloomooloo:

- (A) Between the points 9 metres and 31.5 metres (four car spaces) west of Bourke Street as "1P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area 28".
- (B) Between the points 31.5 metres and 41.5 metres (two car spaces) west of Bourke Street as "No Stopping".

**DECISION**

**BACKGROUND**

A resident of Harmer Street has requested consideration of permit parking in Harmer Street to increase parking turn over in the street.

**COMMENTS**

The kerb space on the northern side of Harmer Street, Woolloomooloo between Bourke Street and the dead end is currently unrestricted for parking.

Parking occupancy surveys show that 80% of parking is occupied in an average weekday in this section of Harmer Street.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide timed permit parking to increase parking turnover and improve resident access to on-street parking.

The proposed changes would limit any vehicle which does not have a permit to one hour of parking from 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday where the signs are installed.

Residents with an Area 28 permit will be exempt from the one hour time limit.

This parking restriction is consistent with other timed permit parking restrictions in the immediate area

**CONSULTATION**

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 18 letters sent out with no response supporting the proposal and no responses opposing the proposal.

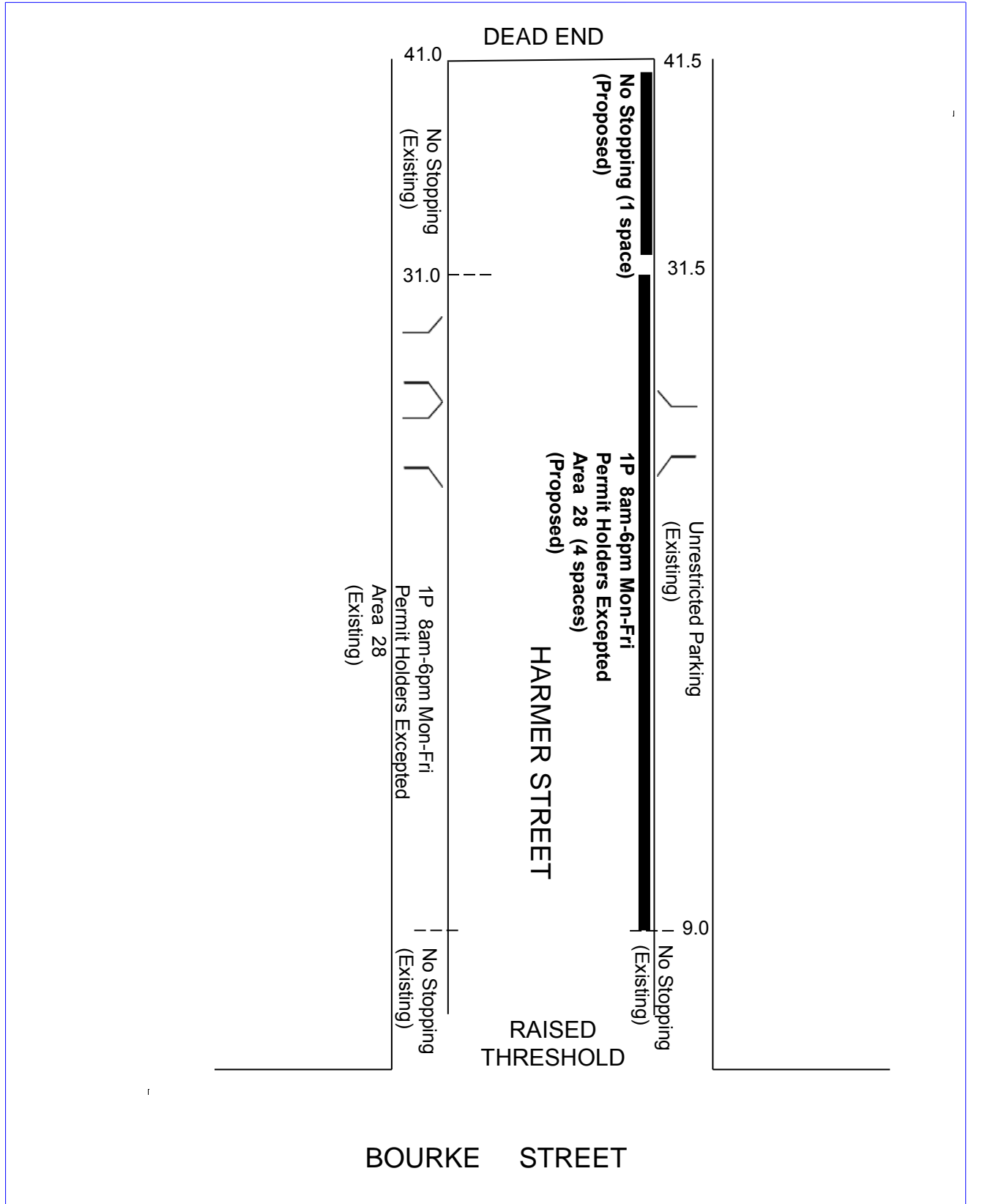
**FINANCIAL**
