INTERSECTION OF GADIGAL AVENUE AND WOLSELEY GROVE
ZETLAND**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee note the proposed installation of new traffic signals at the intersection of Gadigal Avenue and Wolseley Grove in Zetland.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

In response to concerns about pedestrian safety and increased traffic demands at the intersection of Gadigal Avenue and Wolseley Grove, it is proposed to signalise the existing “STOP”-controlled intersection to improve pedestrian and vehicular safety at the location.

COMMENTS

The installation of new traffic signals will significantly improve pedestrian and vehicular safety at the intersection Gadigal Avenue and Wolseley Grove, Zetland.

The Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) is the consent authority for all traffic signals. In September 2015, the RMS accepted and approved the Traffic Control Signal (TCS) plan to install signals at the location.

CONSULTATION

Consultation is not required as RMS is the consent authority for traffic signal sites.

City staff will notify nearby residents and businesses four weeks before construction work commences.

FINANCIAL

Funds are available in the current budget.
