

ITEM 50. PARKING – LOADING ZONE – MACLEAY STREET POTTS POINT

TRIM RECORD NO: 2015/407625

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the western side of Macleay Street between the points 10 metres and 17 metres (one car space) north of Rockwall Crescent as “Loading Zone 6am-4pm, Mon-Fri; 6am-10am, Sat” and “Mail Zone At Other Times”.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

At an on-site meeting between the City, residents and local businesses on 26 June 2015, it was requested that the City consider the provision of additional on-street loading opportunities in the vicinity of Rockwall Crescent, Potts Point.

COMMENTS

The kerb space on the western side of Macleay Street, north of Rockwall Crescent, is currently signposted as “Mail Zone”.

Given that local residents and business communicated a need for more loading opportunities in the vicinity of Rockwall Crescent, the City explored the possibility of utilising the existing “Mail Zone” for loading outside of peak mail drop-off and pick-up times.

Australia Post were consulted on, and provided ‘in principle’ support for, the proposed parking changes.

CONSULTATION

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 656 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

FINANCIAL

Funds are available in the current budget.
