

**ITEM 69. TRAFFIC TREATMENT – CHEVRON ISLANDS ACROSS  
DRIVEWAYS**

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the implementation of painted chevron islands across a private driveway within the City's Local Government Area subject to the following:

- (A) The property owner formally requests the implementation of the painted chevron island in writing; and
- (B) The property owner resolves any outstanding fees associated with the request.

**DECISION**

**BACKGROUND**

The City regularly receives requests from local residents and businesses for solutions to deter illegal parking across driveways.

Although Rule 198 (2) of the *Road Rules 2014* makes it illegal for a vehicle to park across a driveway, at times additional treatments are required to reinforce Rule 198 (2). One such option is the implementation of painted chevron islands across driveways.

**COMMENTS**

Given that the City actively seeks options to reduce street clutter, the provision of signage across a driveway to deter illegal parking is not consistent with this position.

One option that can be considered by the City to deter illegal parking is the installation of painted chevron islands across a driveway. Painted chevron islands avoids street clutter and provides a visual aid to discourage vehicles parking across an access driveway.

As the City charges a fee for the implementation of a painted chevron island, the City will only install a painted chevron island across a private driveway at the request of the owner and following confirmation of payment.

Rather than refer all future requests for painted chevron islands across a driveway to the Local Pedestrian, Cycling and Traffic Calming Committee for consideration and endorsement, the City proposes to proceed with their installation subject to receiving a formal request in writing from the property owner and the resolution of any outstanding fees.
