**DECISION**

**BACKGROUND**

The City has received safety concerns of vehicles in Rainford Street, Surry Hills approaching the intersection of Bourke Street at speed and not giving way to bike riders using the Bourke Street separated cycleway.

**COMMENTS**

The City supports bicycle riding as a low cost, environmentally friendly mode of transport that can help to improve the liveability of our towns and cities.

The City is proposing to introduce a Give Way control at the intersection of Rainford Street with Bourke Street to improve the safety of bike riders on Bourke Street cycleway as well as pedestrians.

**CONSULTATION**

Consultation is not required as the new traffic treatment does not affect the existing road network.

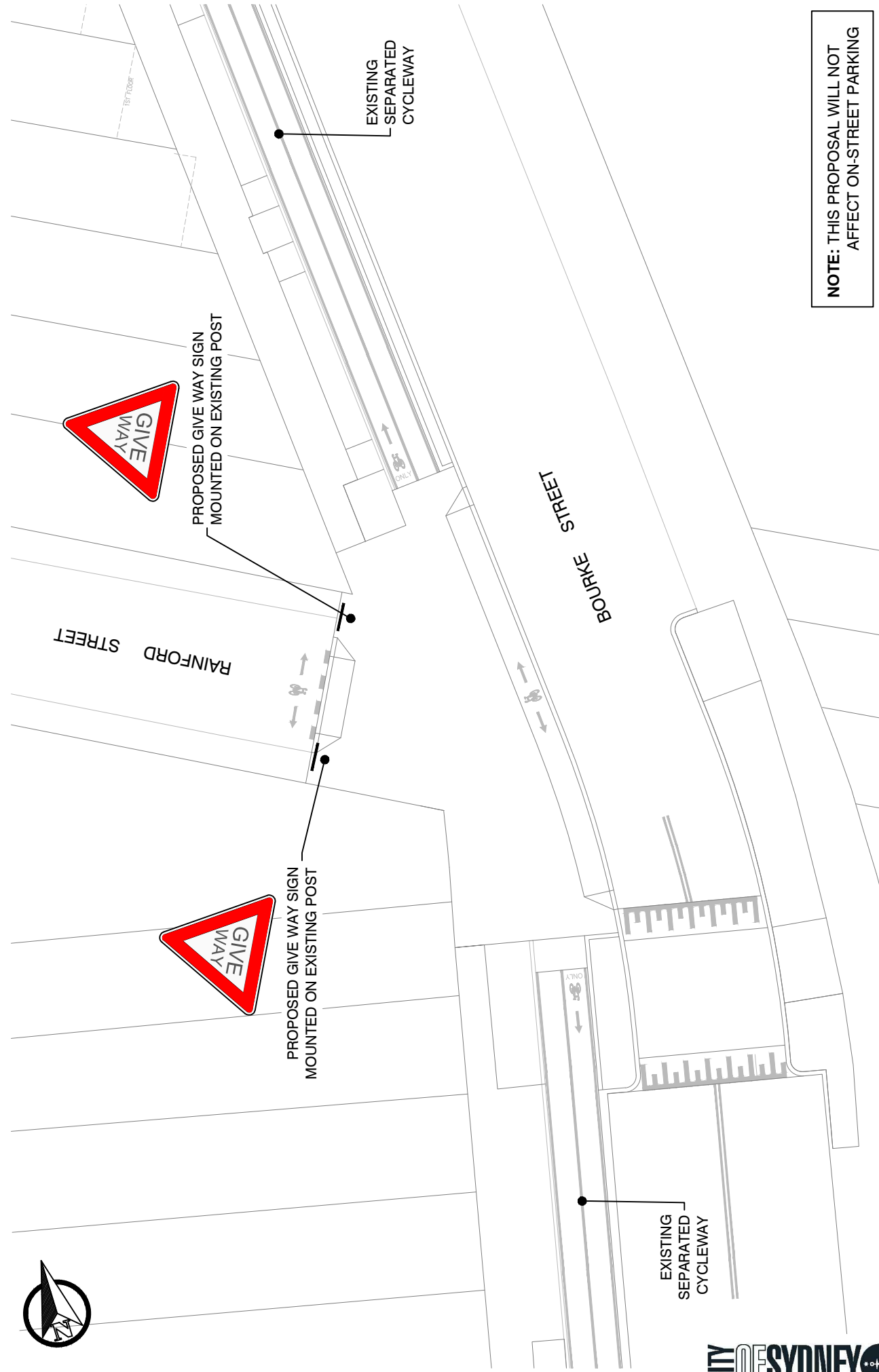
**FINANCIAL**
