

**ITEM 35. PARKING – NO STOPPING – ST NEOT AVENUE AND WYLDE  
STREET POTTS POINT**

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the following reallocation of parking in Potts Point:

- (A) On the southern side of St Neot Avenue, between the points 0 metres and 13.8 metres (two car spaces), west of Wylde Street as “No Stopping”; and
- (B) On the western side of Wylde Street, between the points 0 metres and 10 metres (two car spaces), south of St Neot Avenue as “No Stopping”; and
- (C) On the western side of Wylde Street, between the points 10 metres and 22 metres (two car spaces), south of St Neot Avenue as “1P 8am-10pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area 19”.

**DECISION**

**BACKGROUND**

Australia Post has removed the mail box at this location and advised that the “Mail Zone” is no longer required.

**COMMENTS**

The kerb space on the south-western corner of St Neot Avenue and Wylde Street is currently signposted as “Mail Zone” and “1P 8am-10pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area 19”.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a “No Stopping” restriction to comply with RMS Statutory Restrictions. There will be a loss of two permit parking spaces due to the proposal.

**CONSULTATION**

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 223 letters sent out with one response opposing the proposal due to the loss of parking.

The City is required to enforce parking restrictions in accordance with the Road Rules 2008, which prohibit stopping within 10 metres of an intersection without traffic lights.

Signposting of restrictions is required where there is adjoining signposting or if there are compliance or safety issues.

Parking at intersections can obstruct driver vision and cause unsafe conditions especially for pedestrians crossing the road.

Funds are available in the current budget.
