DECISION

BACKGROUND

The Surry Hills Neighbourhood Centre has applied for the temporary road closures of Marlborough Street, north of Devonshire Street and Collins Street, between Crown Street and Richards Lane, for the Surry Hills Festival 2016 on Saturday 24 September, from 6am to 10pm.

COMMENTS

The Surry Hills Festival will be held on Saturday 24 September 2016. The event will occur in and around Ward Park and Shannon Reserve and include activities in two side-streets.

The event is a fundraiser for Surry Hills Neighbourhood Centre community programs. The Festival will create a sense of belonging amongst the whole community and celebrate the diversity of the neighbourhood.

The Surry Hills Festival 2016 is an event that requires the temporary closure of road and traffic detours around the event.

Road Closures

Marlborough Street north of Devonshire Street and Collins Street, between Crown Street and Richards Lane.

Closed between 6am to 10pm.

The roads will be occupied by pedestrian traffic and creative activations.

The Applicant has provided a site-specific Traffic Control Plan that includes details of barricades, signs, flagmen and other traffic devices to implement the proposed road closure.

There are currently no other approved temporary road closures proposed to take place on the same day in close proximity of these closures.

The temporary road closure will not affect any other properties as local access will be provided at all times and alternative access routes are available nearby.

CONSULTATION

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders as stipulated in Schedule B.

All costs associated with the proposed closures will be borne by the Applicant
