It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the northern side of Abercrombie Street west of Ivy Street, Darlington between the points 6 metres and 19.3 metres (two parking spaces) as "1P 8am-10pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 32".

DECISION

BACKGROUND

The City of Sydney proposes to introduce additional permit parking spaces along the northern kerbside of Abercrombie Street west of Ivy Street, Darlington by reducing the distance of the "No Stopping" restriction which is currently excessive. This will create increased parking opportunities for short term visitors and business customers in the area.

COMMENTS

On-site inspection shows that there is a need to provide additional permit parking spaces to create more parking opportunities for residents, visitors and business customers in the area.

The kerb space on the northern side of Abercrombie Street west of Ivy Street where the changes are proposed is currently signposted as "No Stopping" for a distance of 19.3 metres. Since Ivy Street is a one way street travelling northbound away from Abercrombie Street, the length of the "No Stopping" restriction is excessive and serves no purpose.

To create more parking spaces, the length of the "No Stopping" restriction along the kerb space could be reduced. This allows for two additional permit parking spaces to be installed along the kerb space.

The proposed changes would limit any vehicle which does not have a permit to one (1) hour of parking from 8am to 10pm where the signs are installed.

Residents with an Area 32 parking permit will be exempt from the one-hour time limit.

CONSULTATION

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 106 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.


FINANCIAL
