It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the northern side of Lawson Street, Redfern between the points 11 metres and 21 metres west of Eveleigh Street as “2P 8am-10pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 32”.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

The City is considering a proposal to move the two parking spaces allocated to the Tribal Warrior Association on Lawson Street to a new location in Caroline Street, Redfern. The proposal would allow for two additional residential parking spaces on Lawson Street.

As part of the Lawson Street/Square Cycleway project, there will be a small loss in parking due to a proposed wider pedestrian footpath, new cycleway and in-road trees. Therefore, the two additional parking spaces provided by relocating the Tribal Warrior parking will balance out any loss caused by the project.

COMMENTS

Part of the kerb space on the northern side of Lawson Street, Redfern between Eveleigh Street and Abercrombie Street is currently signposted as “No Parking, Authorised Tribal Warriors Association Vehicles Excepted”.

The City is proposing that this existing Authorised Vehicle Zone be moved to a new location in Caroline Street, as the new location consists of unrestricted parking and will not affect residents. The existing Police Zone in Lawson Street will remain.

The reallocation of these two parking spaces are to compensate for the minor loss in permit parking which will be caused by the Lawson Street/Square Cycleway project.

CONSULTATION

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 571 letters sent out with 1 response supporting the proposal and none opposing the proposal. The one response supporting the proposal was submitted by the CEO of the Tribal Warrior Association.

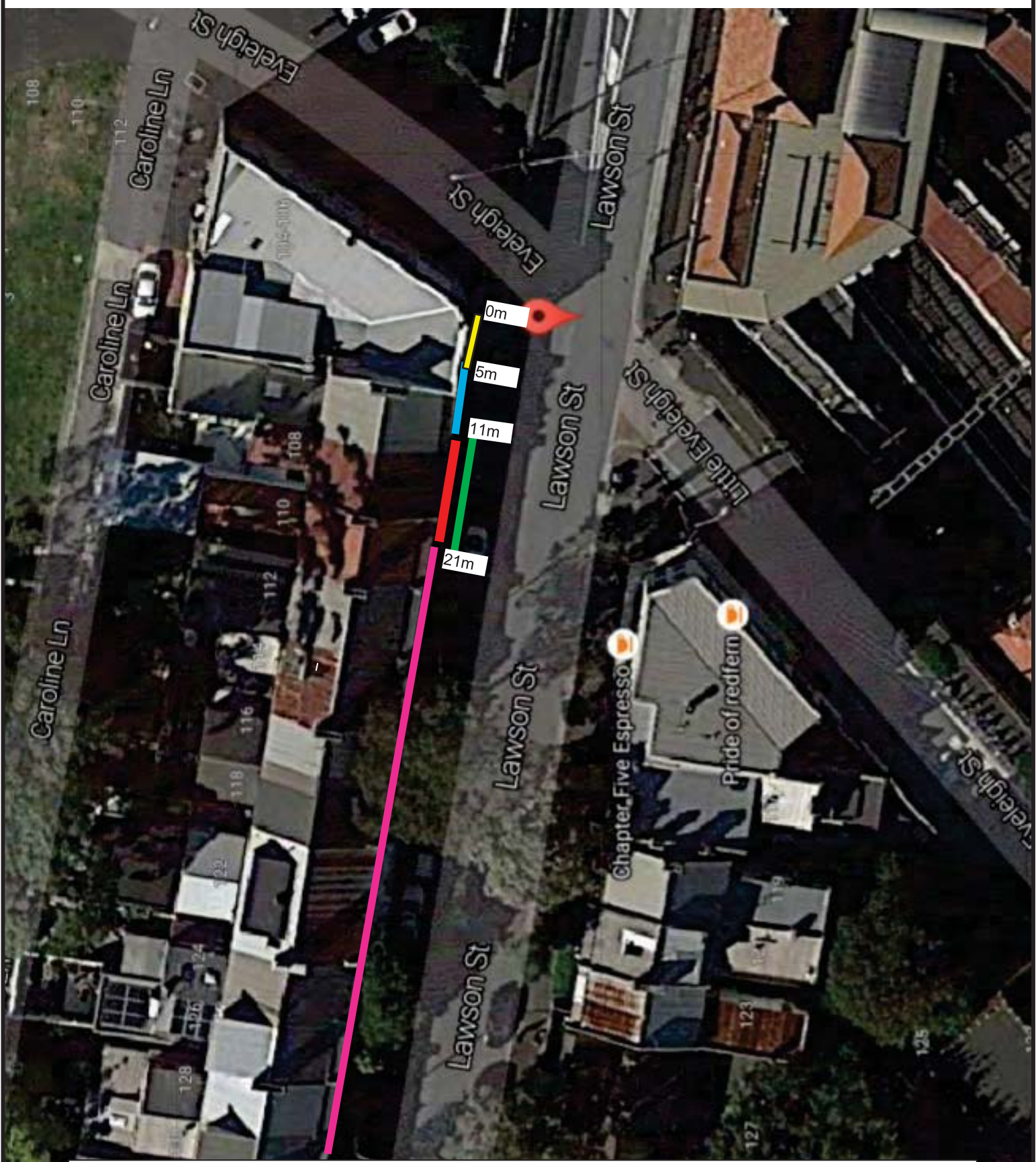
FINANCIAL
