RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the temporary road closure of Moore Park Road, Centennial Park for the Sydney Derby Double Header on Saturday 14 January 2016 from 8pm to 12am (midnight) subject to the following conditions:-

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as stipulated in Schedule B of this agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must contact the Surry Hills Police to discuss deployment of user pay police for the event.
- (C) The Applicant must contact the City's Venue Management Unit to discuss the event.
- (D) The Applicant is to obtain a Road Occupancy Licence from the Transport Management Centre prior to commencement of works.
- (E) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed event and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

The Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground Trust has applied for the temporary road closure of westbound traffic on Moore Park Road for the Sydney Derby Double Header on Saturday 14 January 2016 from 8pm to 12am (midnight).

COMMENTS

The Sydney Derby Double Header is an event that requires the temporary closure of westbound traffic on Moore Park Road and traffic management around the event location.

On 14 January 2016, Allianz Stadium and Sydney Cricket Ground are hosting the Sydney FC versus Western Sydney Wanderers (A League) game and the Sydney Sixers versus

Sydney Thunder (Big Bash League) game. The closure is required to manage pedestrians leaving the event along Moore Park Road.

The road will be occupied by pedestrian traffic and barriers to control the expected volumes of pedestrian traffic.

The Applicant has provided a site-specific Traffic Control Plan that includes details of barricades, signs, flagmen and other traffic devices to implement the proposed road closure.

The temporary road closure will not affect any other properties as local access will be provided at all times and alternative access routes are available nearby.

Temporary Road Closures – Saturday 14 January 2016, 8pm to 12am (midnight)

- The westbound traffic lanes on Moore Park Road, between Driver Avenue and Oxford Street

There are currently no other approved temporary road closures in the area proposed to take place on the same day in close proximity of these closures.

CONSULTATION

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders as stipulated in Schedule B.

FINANCIAL

All costs associated with the proposed closure will be borne by the Applicant.

Moore Park Rd (Eastbound) will remain open at Flinders St.

Managed Crossings: Police and Traffic controllers to work to either hold pedestrians or traffic until safe to allow cross of pedestrians onto Northern side of Moore Park Road. Pedestrians to be directed onto the footpaths of Moore Park road and adjoining Streets.

Overview of Closure of Moore Park Rd:

Westbound closure of Moore Park Rd to allow for additional pedestrian space during egress from both sporting events.

Traffic Controllers and Police will manage crossings at Oatley Rd, Regent St and Flinders St.

TCP's will be provided that provide in-depth detail of the treatments at each intersection.

Traffic control staff and User-pay police will be deployed to manage crossings and safely direct pedestrians along footpaths

With 40min difference in finish times, it is foreseeable that 80-90% of egress from Cricket (SCG) may be possible before Soccer (Allianz) commences Egress.

Eastern Distributor Exit onto Moore Park Road closed and messaged in ED Tunnel by TMC

Gates A, C, K egress via Allianz Forecourt to Driver Avenue

Gate I, Back of Floor and possibly Gate H to exit via Tractor Chute egress to SCG Gate A on to Driver Ave.

Gates E, H & G, exit out onto Moore Park Road Stairs

Contingency closure. Only required if the management of pedestrians crossing and vehicles exiting onto Moore park Rd becomes too congested.

Pedestrian Fencing installed on Moore Park Road between Regent St and Driver Ave, giving additional pedestrian capacity along Moore Park Rd. With gaps at 'split' points to provide managed crossings to allow pedestrian flows to adjoining streets of Moore Park Rd.

Moore Park Road Closed (Westbound) at Oxford St from 8PM – 12Midnight. TCP Phase 'A' will allow Local Access only from Oxford St to Lang Rd & Cook Rd. TCP Phase 'B' will be a full westbound closure and will be implemented if requested by Police.

Emergency Vehicles
 Median Lane westbound will remain available for emergency vehicle access during closure.

Moore Park Road closed Westbound at Lang Rd.
