RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the eastern side of Tusculum Lane, Potts Point, between the points 17 metres and 22 metres (one car space), north of Hughes Street as "No Stopping".

DECISION

BACKGROUND

A resident of Victoria Street has requested consideration to extend the No Stopping restriction on the eastern side of Tusculum Lane, Potts Point, to provide rear lane vehicular access to their property.

COMMENTS

The kerb space on the eastern side of Tusculum Lane, Potts Point, is currently signposted as "No Stopping", "No Parking" and 1P Permit Parking.

Tusculum Lane is approximately 5 metres wide and provides rear-lane property access to houses fronting both Tusculum and Victoria Streets.

Under existing conditions, when a vehicle parks in Tusculum Lane two-way traffic flow is reduced to a single lane. This restricts rear-lane property access for houses fronting both Tusculum and Victoria Streets which is illegal under Section 6 of the Roads Act 1993 which gives adjoining land owners a right of vehicle access to the public road.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to extend the existing 'No Stopping" restriction to maintain rear-lane property access.

CONSULTATION

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 42 letters sent out with no responses supporting the proposal and one response opposing the proposal due to the loss of 1P Permit Parking.

Section 6 of the *Roads Act 1993* gives adjoining land owners a right of vehicle access to the public road. Complying with this legislation sometimes results in the loss of on-street parking.




