DECISION

BACKGROUND

The City is removing unnecessary signs across driveways as they increase the proliferation of street signage, adds to the visual clutter and creates hazards for pedestrians on the footpath.

COMMENTS

The majority of the kerb space on the eastern side of Ivy Street, Darlington between Abercrombie Street and Boundary Street is currently signposted as "1P 8am-10pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 32". However, there are some "No Stopping" restrictions across driveways which have been in place for a number of years.

The current "No Stopping" signs contradict the Road Rules. The City is therefore proposing to remove the signs and provide holding lines on either side of driveways to mark the limits where parking is legally permitted.

Signs are not required across driveways in order for enforcement to occur and signs are not installed to remind road users of the above restriction that applies to all driveways.

CONSULTATION

The City notified local residents and businesses in the area. There were 60 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

FINANCIAL

Funds are available in the current budget.
