DECISION

BACKGROUND

The City is proposing to widen the footpath on the southern side of Eglinton Road, Glebe, east of Edward Lane, to improve pedestrian access and calm traffic.

COMMENTS

Currently, the kerb ramps to cross Edward Lane at Eglinton Road are not aligned.

The City's proposal to widen the footpath on the southern side of Eglinton Road, Glebe, east of Edward Lane, to align the kerb ramps would improve pedestrian access and safety including the mobility and vision impaired.

The proposal would also help improve general safety in the area as part of the City's commitment to calm traffic and improve residential amenity.

There will be no loss to kerbside parking spaces and the treatment will not affect traffic flow.

CONSULTATION

The City notified the local residents and businesses in the area. There were 59 letters sent with no response supporting or opposing the proposal.

FINANCIAL

Appropriate funding for the proposal will be secured once greater certainty on the construction timeline is reached.

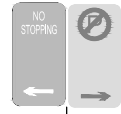
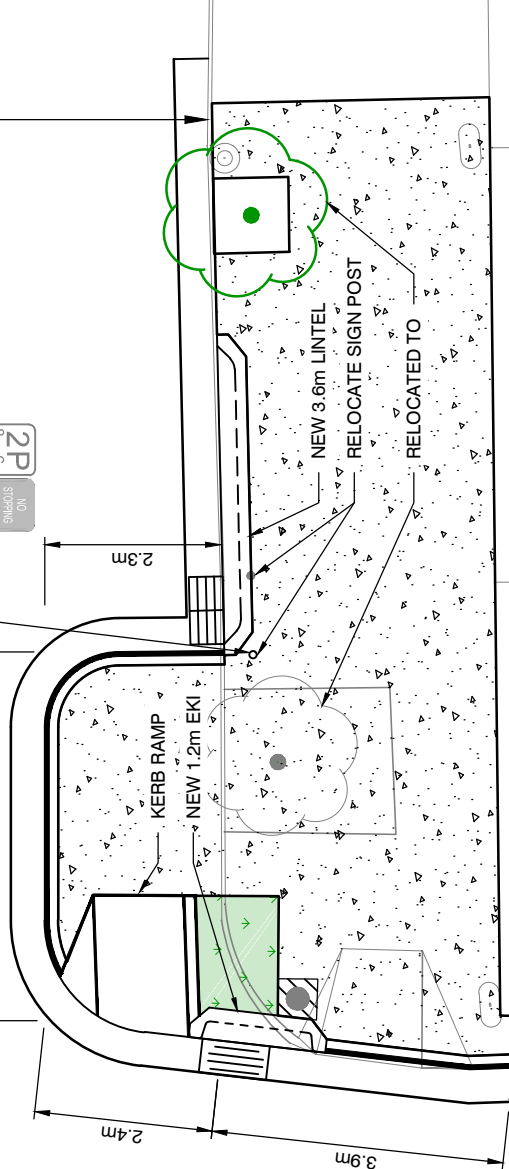
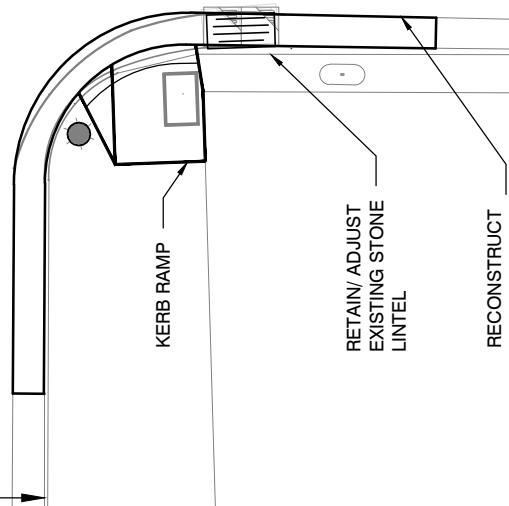
