- (B) The reallocation of kerb space as "No Stopping".

DECISION

BACKGROUND

The Developer of 37-49 O'Connor Street, Chippendale has requested a change to the southern side of O'Connor Street to facilitate a new driveway access. This would involve removal of an existing indented parking bay and the widening of the footpath to match the adjacent treatments.

COMMENTS

The City has approved the redevelopment of 37-49 O'Connor Street, Chippendale which includes the provision of a new driveway located within an existing indented parking bay.

O'Connor Street is approximately 6 metres wide, with all existing parking spaces provided with indented bays. The kerb space within the indented bays, on the southern side of O'Connor Street, between Kensington and Abercrombie Streets, is currently signposted as "2P Ticket 8am-10pm, Permit Holders Excepted Area 32". The kerbspace outside of the indented parking bays, is signposted as "No Stopping".

The provision of the new driveway will result in the removal of the indented parking bay and the footpath widened to be consistent with the kerb line on the rest of the street. Additionally the adjacent "No Stopping" would be extended to cover the new kerb line along the widened footpath.

CONSULTATION

Consultation with the affected stakeholders was undertaken as a part of the Development Application process for 37-49 O'Connor Street, Chippendale.


FINANCIAL
