

ITEM 11. WORKS ZONE – ELIZABETH STREET SURRY HILLS

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the following:

- Reallocation of kerb space on the eastern side of Elizabeth Street, Surry Hills, between the points 20 metres and 32 metres (two car spaces) south of Butt Street as “Bus Lane 6am-10am, 3pm-8pm Mon-Fri” and “Works Zone 10am-3pm Mon-Fri, 7.30am-3.30pm Sat”; and
- Reallocation of kerb space on the eastern side of Elizabeth Street, Surry Hills, between the points 32 metres and 44 metres (two car spaces) south of Butt Street as “Bus Lane 6am-10am, 3pm-8pm Mon-Fri” and “Disability Parking At Other Times”.

Subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the Works Zone conditions as stipulated in Schedule C of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant is not permitted to operate any part of a crane over a public road or hoist/swing goods from a Works Zone across or over any part of a public road by means of a lift, hoist or crane unless a separate approval has been obtained from the City's Construction and Building Certification Services Unit as required under Section 68 of the Local Government Act 1993 and Section 138 of the Roads Act 1993.
- (C) Works for major transport projects, such as the CBD and South-East Light Rail (CSELR) project and the Sydney City Centre Access Strategy, are currently being undertaken in the City's Local Government Area and have priority access and use rights over City-owned or controlled land including roads and footpaths. The City may at any time, and with at least one business days' notice to the Applicant, revoke, suspend or restrict the Works Zone:
 - if the Works Zone is required for a major transport project; or
 - is impracticable due to changes arising from a major transport project, such as traffic diversions; or
 - is otherwise unsuitable due to a major transport project.

The Applicant must make their own enquiries, on a regular basis, about the potential impact of major transport projects on the Works Zone and the construction program for its development site.

- (D) The Applicant must notify adjacent properties of the Works Zone at least seven days prior to installation.
- (E) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the Site Manager.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

Growth Built Pty Ltd has applied for a 12 metre long Works Zone in Elizabeth Street, Surry Hills.

The Works Zone is to facilitate construction works at 432-436 Elizabeth Street for a period of approximately 60 weeks.

COMMENTS

The kerb space on the eastern side of Elizabeth Street, Surry Hills between Butt and Brumby Streets, where the Works Zone is proposed, is currently signposted as “Bus Lane 6am-10am, 3pm-8pm Mon-Fri” and “Disability Parking At Other Times”.

The proposed Works Zone will require the temporarily relocation of the two existing disability parking spaces immediately south of their current location.

The Works Zone is intended to operate from 10am to 3pm, Monday to Friday and from 7.30am to 3.30pm on Saturdays in accordance with the Development Consent Conditions.

The Applicant has forwarded their Construction Traffic Management Plan (CTMP) to the Sydney Coordination Office (SCO). The proposed Works Zone is part of the CTMP.

CONSULTATION

The Applicant must notify adjacent properties at least seven days prior to the implementation of the Works Zone.

FINANCIAL

All costs associated with the Works Zone will be borne by the Applicant.
