DECISION

BACKGROUND

The Development Consent for the Green Square Town Centre (D/2012/1175/F) requires the Applicant to deliver a new signalised pedestrian crossing across Joynton Avenue Zetland, 106 metres north of Hansard Road.

The delivery of the new signalised pedestrian crossing will address Condition 15 and 26 for the development of the Green Square Town Centre.

Zetland Avenue is a new street providing pedestrian, cycle and vehicular connections through the town centre. Zetland Avenue parking restrictions will be considered as part of a separate item.

COMMENTS

The new signalised crossing will provide pedestrian access and provide a connection between the Aquatic Centre (Epsom Park Precinct) and the Community Centre (Green Square Town Centre).

On 20 October 2016, Roads and Maritime Services approved the Traffic Control Signal Plan for the proposed signal controlled pedestrian crossing at Joynton Avenue, Zetland.

CONSULTATION

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area through a community engagement event for Green Square proposals and publication of the proposal on the *"SydneyYourSay"* website. Over 100 people attended the event and 340 people visited the webpage.

There were no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

FINANCIAL

Funds are available as part of the Green Square Project budget.
