DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously out-of-session on 25 August 2017.

BACKGROUND

At the 19 July 2017 meeting of the Local Pedestrian, Cycling and Traffic Calming Committee (LPCTCC), the Committee endorsed the temporary road closure for Goderich Lane, between Pennys Lane and Ward Avenue, Potts Point, on 2-4 and 7-9 August 2017 from 7.30am to 5.30pm and the alternative date in case of inclement weather on 16-18 and 21-23 August 2017.

The Applicant has advised that the temporary road closure could not be carried out on the approved and alternative dates.

As such, the Applicant has requested that the:

- temporary road closure be rescheduled to 4-6 September 2017, between 7.30am to 5.30pm; and
- alternate dates in case of inclement weather be rescheduled to 6-8 September 2017.

COMMENTS

The City circulated the change of dates to the relevant voting LPCTCC members and the Transport Management Centre (TMC) for consideration. The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously out-of-session on 25 August 2017.
