RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee note the temporary road closure of Coulson Street between Flora and Eve Streets, Erskineville, on Saturday 7 October and Sunday 8 October 2017 from 7am to 6pm, subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as mentioned in Schedule B of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must comply with any other conditions imposed by City's Construction Regulation Unit.
- (C) The Applicant must contact Redfern Police to obtain a separate police permit and to discuss deployment of user pay police for the road.
- (D) The Applicant must use RMS-Accredited Traffic Controllers to manage local vehicular access into and out of Coulson Street during the temporary road closure.
- (E) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed closure and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.
- (F) The Applicant must contact Sydney Buses and arrange and pay for the rerouting of bus services around the temporary relocation of bus stops and any additional staff required.

DECISION

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously out-of-session on 3 October 2017.

BACKGROUND

Platinum Traffic Services applied for the temporary road closure of Coulson Street between Flora and Eve Streets, Erskineville, on Saturday 7 October and Sunday 8 October 2017 from 7am to 6pm.

COMMENTS

The proposed temporary road closure was required to enable Sydney Train Track works and Bridge works.

The Applicant provided a site-specific Traffic Control Plan that included details of barricades, signs, flagmen and other traffic devices to implement the proposed road closure.

There were no other approved temporary road closures proposed to take place on the same day in close proximity of this closure.

The temporary road closure did not affect any other properties, as local access was provided at all times and alternative access routes were available nearby.
