

**ITEM 13. MOBILE CRANES – TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – BRODRICK  
STREET CAMPERDOWN**

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the temporary road closure of Brodrick Street, Camperdown, between Missenden Road and Church Street, on Wednesday 15 November 2017 from 7am to 5pm, subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as mentioned in Schedule B of this Agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must comply with any other conditions imposed by City's Construction Regulation Unit.
- (C) The Applicant has indicated Wednesday 22 November 2017 as an alternative date in case of inclement weather.
- (D) The Applicant must contact the Newtown Police to obtain a separate police permit and to discuss deployment of user pay police for the road closure.
- (E) The Applicant must liaise directly with the Rydges Camperdown hotel to discuss servicing and car park access during the temporary road closure at least two weeks prior to the work.
- (F) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed closure and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.

**DECISION**

**BACKGROUND**

At the 19 July 2017 meeting of the Local Pedestrian, Cycling and Traffic Calming Committee (LPCTCC), the Committee endorsed the temporary closure of Brodrick Street, Camperdown, between Missenden Road and Church Street, on Wednesday 9 August 2017 from 7am to 5pm and the alternative date in case of inclement weather on Wednesday 23 August 2017.

The Applicant has advised that the temporary road closure could not be carried out on the approved and alternative dates. As such, the Applicant is seeking approval for the

temporary road closure to be rescheduled to Wednesday 15 November 2017 from 7am to 5pm, and the alternative date in case of inclement weather to Wednesday 22 November 2017.

### **COMMENTS**

The proposed temporary road closure is required to allow a mobile crane to install a tower crane at 15 Brodrick Street, Camperdown.

The Applicant has provided a site-specific Traffic Control Plan that includes details of barricades, signs, flagmen and other traffic devices to implement the proposed road closure.

There are currently no other approved temporary road closures proposed to take place on the same day in close proximity of this closure.

The temporary road closure will not affect any other properties, as local access will be provided at all times and alternative access routes are available nearby.

A Traffic Management Plan (TMP) for the temporary road closure was approved by Roads and Maritime Services (RMS).

### **CONSULTATION**

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders as stipulated in Schedule B.

### **FINANCIAL**

All costs associated with the proposed closure will be borne by the Applicant.

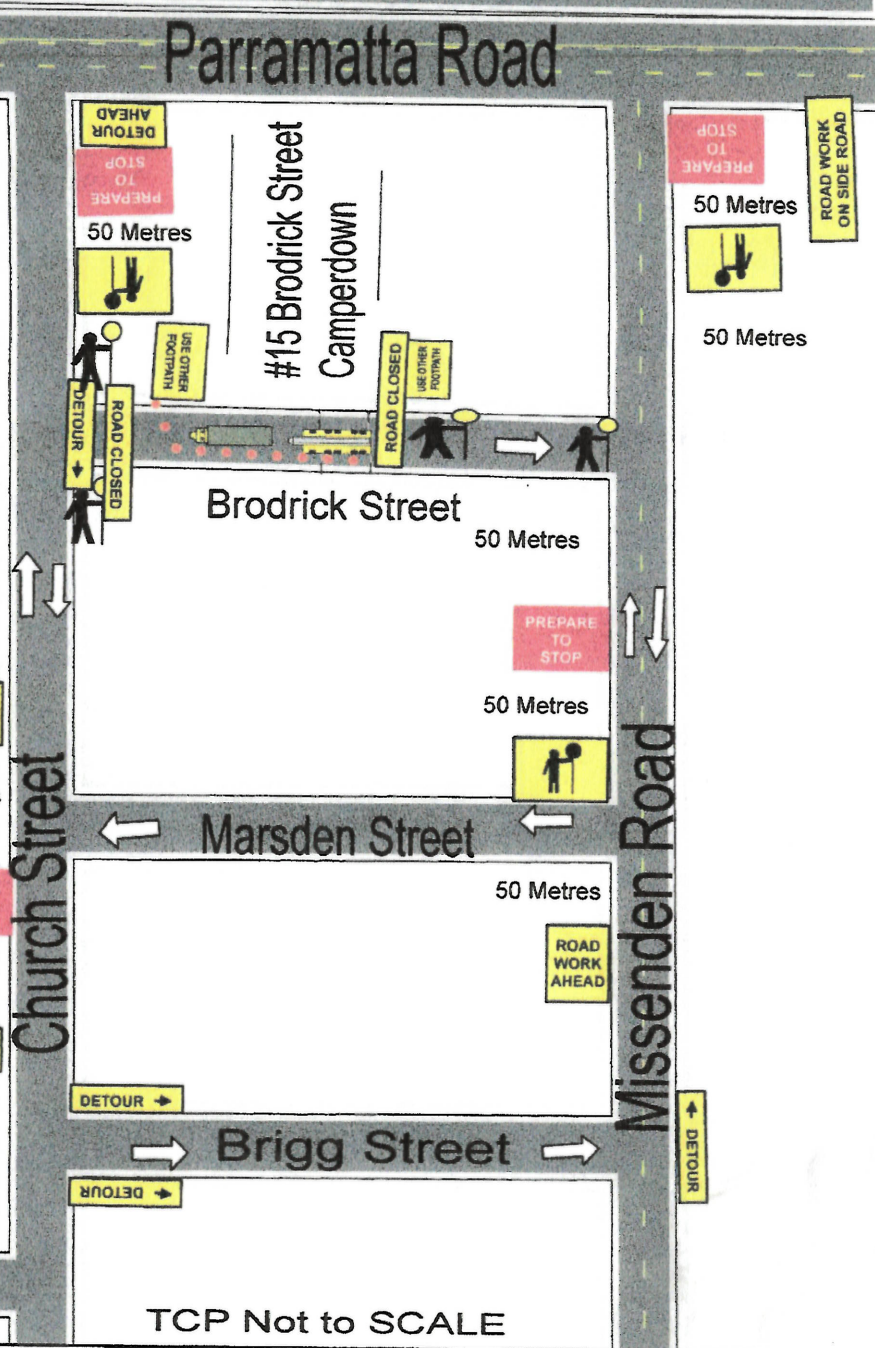
