- (E) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed closure and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

At the 16 August 2017 meeting of the Local Pedestrian, Cycling and Traffic Calming Committee (LPCTCC), the Committee endorsed the temporary closure Eveleigh Street, Redfern, between Hudson and Cleveland Streets, on Friday 1 September 2017 from 9am to 3pm and the alternative date in case of inclement weather on Saturday 2 September 2017.

The Applicant has advised that the temporary road closure could not be carried out on the approved and alternative dates. As such, the Applicant is seeking approval for the temporary road closure to be rescheduled to Tuesday 7 November 2017 from 9am to 3pm, and the alternative date in case of inclement weather to Tuesday 14 November 2017.

COMMENTS

The proposed temporary road closure is required to allow a mobile crane to install a tower crane on 13-31 Eveleigh Street, Redfern.

The Applicant has provided a site-specific Traffic Control Plan that includes details of barricades, signs, flagmen and other traffic devices to implement the proposed road closure.

The temporary road closure will not affect any other properties, as local access will be provided at all times and alternative access routes are available nearby.

A Traffic Management Plan (TMP) for the temporary road closure was approved by Roads and Maritime Services (RMS).

CONSULTATION

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders as stipulated in Schedule B.

FINANCIAL

All costs associated with the proposed closure will be borne by the Applicant.
