### DECISION

# BACKGROUND

A resident has requested pedestrian facilities in Wigram Road, Annandale at Canal Reserve to improve access and safety for pedestrians along the Johnstons Creek path.

## COMMENTS

To improve access and safety for pedestrians crossing Wigram Road along the Johnstons Creek path, it is proposed to introduce a marked pedestrian crossing in Wigram Street at Canal Reserve.

The marked pedestrian crossing will be installed next to an existing raised threshold and combined will further improve general safety in the area as part of the City's commitment to calm traffic and improve residential amenity.

The City has discussed the proposal with Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) and received "in principle" support for the marked pedestrian crossing.

To deliver the marked pedestrian crossing, 4.3 metres of "Bus Zone" on the northern side of Wigram Road will be reallocated as "No Stopping" to comply with RMS Technical Direction for Stopping and Parking Restrictions at Intersections and Crossings (TDT 2002/12c). Sydney Buses has raised no objection to the reduction in length of the "Bus Zone".

### CONSULTATION

The City notified local residents and businesses in the area. There were 411 letters sent out with three responses supporting and no responses opposing the proposal.

## FINANCIAL

Appropriate funding for the proposal will be secured once greater certainty on the construction timeline is reached.
