

**ITEM 48. OTHER AUTHORITIES – PARKING – NO STOPPING – REID
AVENUE WOOLLOOMOOLOO**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the northern side of Reid Avenue, Woolloomooloo, between the points 11.6 metres and 26.4 metres (two car spaces) west of McElhone Street as “No Stopping”.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

Kings Cross LAC has requested consideration for the removal of parking on the northern side of Reid Avenue, Woolloomooloo, between Dowling and McElhone Streets, to reduce conflicts between oncoming vehicles and improve forward visibility and pedestrian safety.

COMMENTS

Reid Avenue, Woolloomooloo, between Dowling and McElhone Streets, is under the control of NSW Land and Housing Corporation.

The kerb space on the northern side of Reid Avenue is currently signposted as “1P 8am-6pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 28”.

Under existing conditions, when a vehicle parks in Reid Avenue two-way traffic flow is reduced to a single lane. Kings Cross LAC have advised that this increases conflicts of oncoming vehicles and reduces forward visibility of vehicles and pedestrians.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to remove parking on the northern side of Reid Avenue to ensure unobstructed two-way access.

CONSULTATION

Roads and Maritime Services consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 30 letters sent out with one response supporting the proposal and no responses opposing the proposal.

NSW Land and Housing Corporation raised no objection to the proposal.

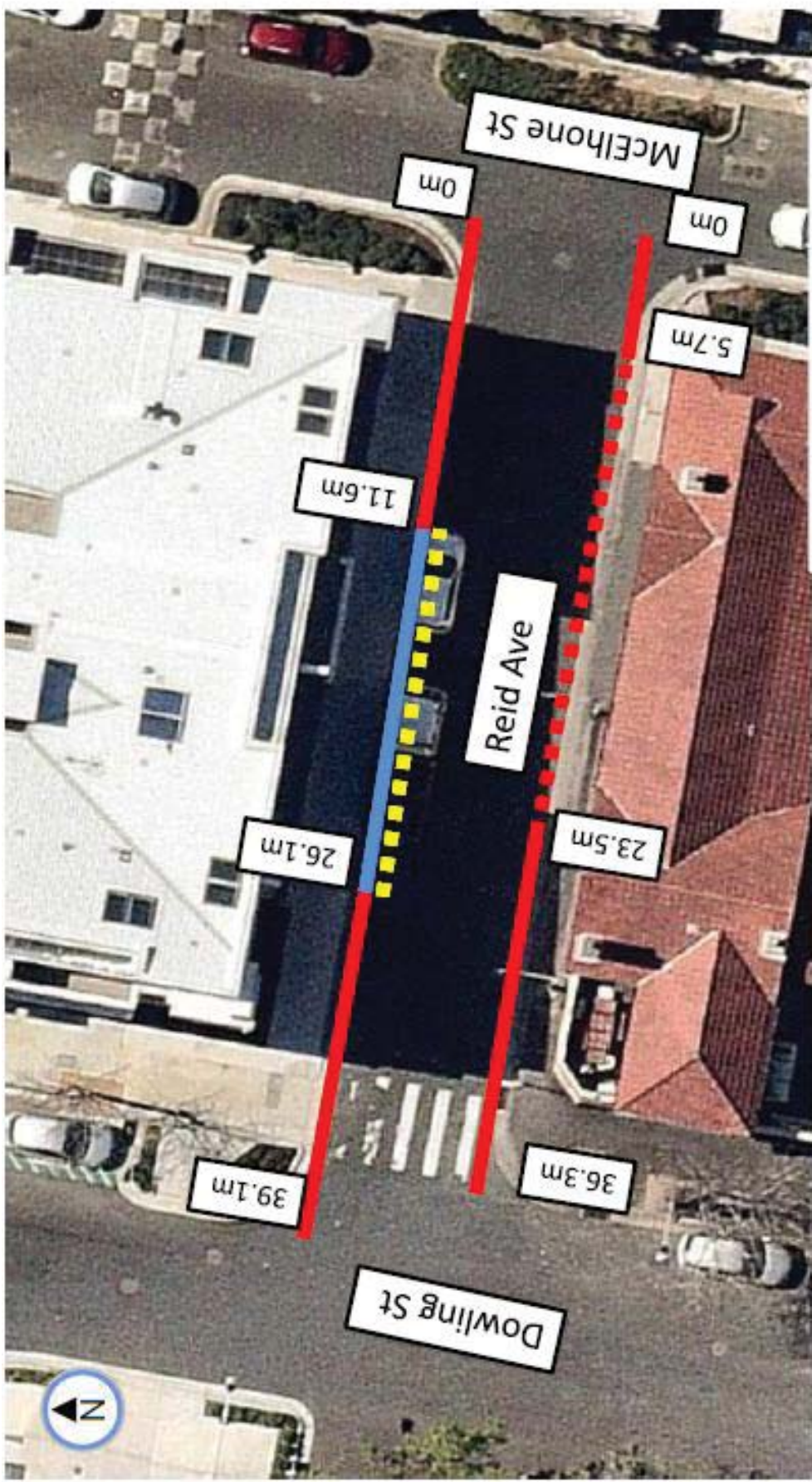
FINANCIAL
