

**ITEM 10. STREET EVENTS – TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES – 2017 SIA
CONCERT**

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the temporary road closure of the westbound traffic lanes on Moore Park Road, Moore Park between Cook Road and Driver Avenue, for the 2017 Sia Concert on Saturday 2 December 2017 from 9.30pm to 11.30pm, subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as stipulated in Schedule A of this agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must contact the Eastern Beaches Police to discuss deployment of user pay police for the event.
- (C) The Applicant must contact the City's Venue Management Unit to discuss the event.
- (D) The Applicant is to obtain a Road Occupancy Licence from the Transport Management Centre prior to commencement of works.
- (E) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed event and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.
- (F) This temporary road closure is to be activated only if it is deemed necessary by the NSW Police for the safe egress of the event crowd.
- (G) The Traffic Management and Traffic Control Plans are agreed to 'in principle' and must be finalised through a Working Group established by the Event Organiser. The Working Group is to be comprised of representatives from NSW Police, Transport for NSW (Transport Management Centre), State Transit Authority, the City, Centennial Park and Moore Park Trust and Event Organisers.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

Event and Sports Projects Australia has applied for the temporary road closure of the westbound lanes on Moore Park Road, Moore Park between Cook Road and Driver Avenue, for the 2017 Sia Concert on Saturday 2 December 2017 from 9.30pm to 11.30pm.

This temporary road closure is to be activated by NSW Police if deemed necessary for the safe egress of the event crowd.

COMMENTS

The Sia Concert is a musical event occurring in Allianz Stadium on Saturday 2 December 2017 from 12 noon to 10.30pm with 30,000 patrons expected to attend. The event may require the temporary closure of westbound traffic on Moore Park Road, Moore Park and traffic management around the event location.

A Road closure may be implemented by the NSW Police – Eastern Beaches Local Area Command from 9.30pm to 11.30pm to assist with the safe movement of pedestrians out of Allianz Stadium. This temporary road closure is to be activated, if required, by NSW Police as late as necessary for the safe egress of the event crowd.

Traffic travelling westbound into Moore Park Road will be diverted to stay on Oxford Street to travel towards the City or south onto South Dowling Street. Vehicles travelling eastbound on Moore Park Road will be able to proceed through to the intersection of Oxford Street. The organisers will work with the Transport Management Centre to monitor flows along these roads to minimise disruptions to motorists.

There will be gaps along Moore Park Road to provide pedestrians opportunities to cross the road at controlled pedestrian crossing points with the assistance of traffic controllers and NSW Police.

VMS messaging will be implemented on Cleveland, Flinders, South Dowling Streets and Anzac Parade to notify drivers of delays and detours.

The temporary road closure will not affect any other properties as local access will be provided at all times and alternative access routes are available nearby.

Temporary Road Closures – Saturday 2 December 2017 – 9.30pm to 11.30pm

- The westbound traffic lanes on Moore Park Road, Moore Park between Cook Road and Driver Avenue.

There are currently no other approved temporary road closures proposed to take place in this area on the same day.

CONSULTATION

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders as stipulated in Schedule A.

FINANCIAL

All costs associated with the proposed closures will be borne by the Applicant.

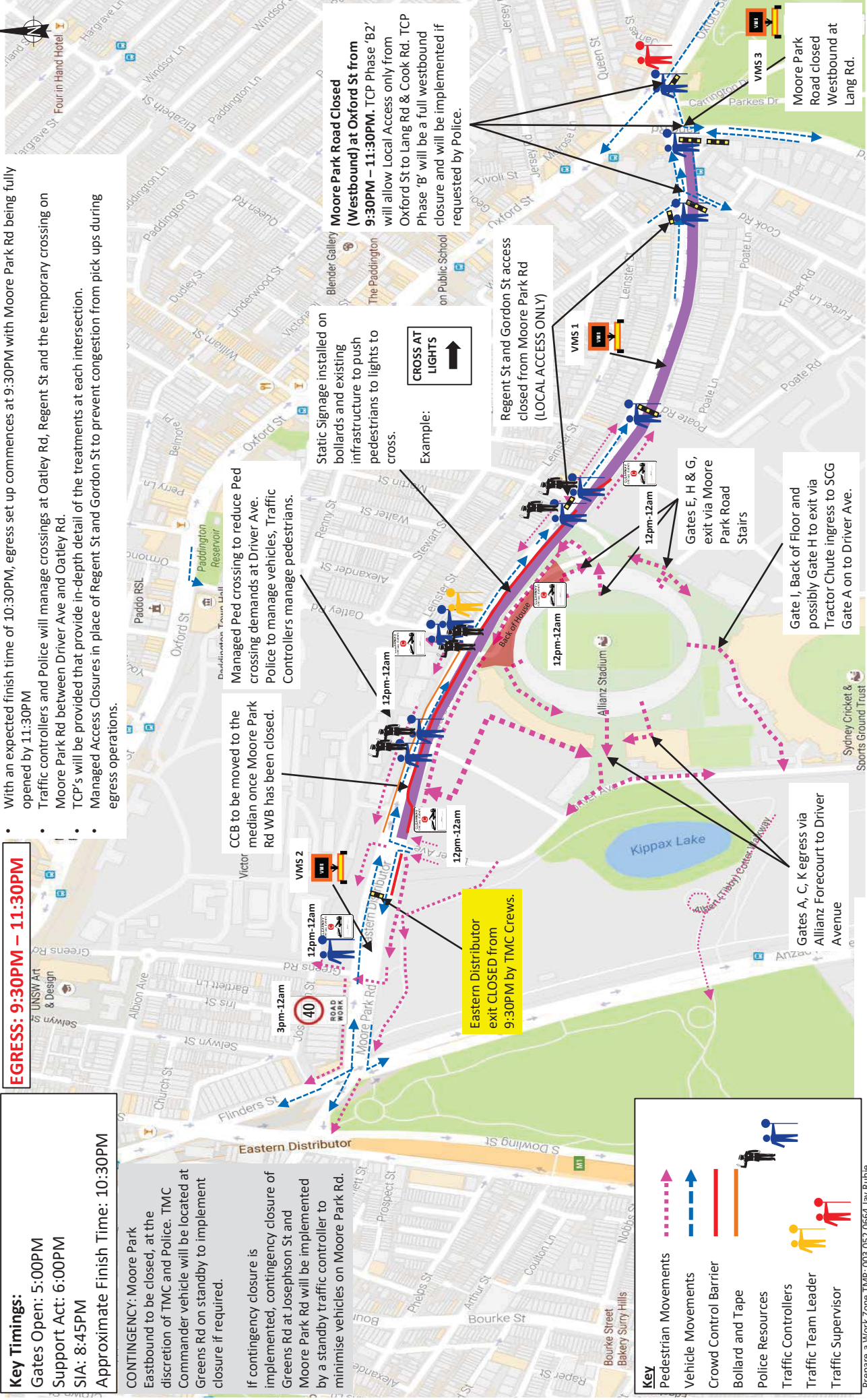
CONTINGENCY: Moore Park Eastbound to be closed, at the discretion of TMC and Police. TMC Commander vehicle will be located at Greens Rd on standby to implement closure if required.

If contingency closure is implemented, contingency closure of Greens Rd at Josephson St and Moore Park Rd will be implemented by a standby traffic controller to minimise vehicles on Moore Park Rd.

EGRESS: 9:30PM – 11:30PM

- Westbound closure of Moore Park Rd required for egress to allow for additional pedestrian space for patrons exiting gates E, G & H from Allianz Stadium
- With an expected finish time of 10:30PM, egress set up commences at 9:30PM with Moore Park Rd being fully opened by 11:30PM
- Traffic controllers and Police will manage crossings at Oatley Rd, Regent St and the temporary crossing on Moore Park Rd between Driver Ave and Oatley Rd.
- TCP's will be provided that provide in-depth detail of the treatments at each intersection.
- Managed Access Closures in place of Regent St and Gordon St to prevent congestion from pick ups during egress operations.
