Construction Solutions Pty Ltd has applied for the temporary road closure of James Lane, Sydney, on Saturday 10 February, Sunday 11 February, Saturday 24 February, Sunday 25 February, Saturday 3 March and Sunday 4 March 2018 from 7am to 5pm.

# **COMMENTS**

The proposed temporary road closure is required for trenching works at the rear of 319-325 Sussex Street, Sydney.

The Applicant has provided a site-specific Traffic Control Plan that includes details of barricades, signs, flagmen and other traffic devices to implement the proposed road closure.

There are currently no other approved temporary road closures proposed to take place on the same day in close proximity of this closure.


