- (B) A Shared Environment on Murray Street, Waterloo just east of Gadigal Avenue, as part of the separated cycleway.

DECISION

BACKGROUND

The Lachlan Precinct, bounded by Bourke, Lachlan and South Dowling Streets and O'Dea Avenue, forms part of the Green Square urban renewal area, will include a new two-way road connecting O'Dea Avenue and Lachlan Street. The road, known as "Gadigal Avenue", will be delivered in parts by the City and by developers of connecting sites.

As part of Development Consent Conditions, the delivery of the new road includes a separated cycleway along the eastern side of Gadigal Avenue, between O'Dea Avenue and Lachlan Street.

COMMENTS

Separated Cycleway

The City has approved the redevelopment of 13-17 Lachlan Street, Waterloo (D/2015/782) which includes the construction of a section of Gadigal Avenue as a new public road.

In July 2017, the Committee endorsed the construction of the section of Gadigal Avenue between Murray Street and Tung Hop Street to facilitate access to the development at 13-17 Lachlan Street.

Additionally, as part of Development Consent Conditions, the Developer of 13-17 Lachlan Street, provided land at the corner of Gadigal Avenue and Murray Street (7-19 Amelia Street) for the City to create a new park named 'Dyuralya Square'.

A separated cycleway is proposed on the eastern side of Gadigal Avenue, adjacent to 'Dyuralya Square'. This will provide a connection between the two sections of separated cycleway already constructed along Gadigal Avenue, from Archibald Avenue and Murray Street.

As part of the separated cycleway, a Shared Environment will also be provided across the intersection at Murray Street to safely manage the interface between pedestrians, cyclists and motorists.

Upon completion of Gadigal Avenue, the separated cycleway will connect O'Dea Avenue and Lachlan Street through to Green Square in the south, and Redfern/Surry Hills in the north.

CONSULTATION

Consultation with the affected stakeholders was undertaken as a part of the Development Application process for 13-17 Lachlan Street, Waterloo.

FINANCIAL

Funds are available in the current budget as part of the City's budget for Dyuralya Square.
